KAYE DON BOOSTS SPEED BOAT MARK TO 110 MILES HR. GARDONE, RIVIERA, Italy, July 10.—(AP)—Kaye Don, British sportsman, has boosted the world's speedboat record to 110.223 miles per hour.

After three months of unsuccessful assaults on the record of 103.49 miles an hour he set off Buenos Aires last spring, Don piloted his Miss England II over a measured course on Lake Garda yesterday at a rate of 107.878 miles an hour.

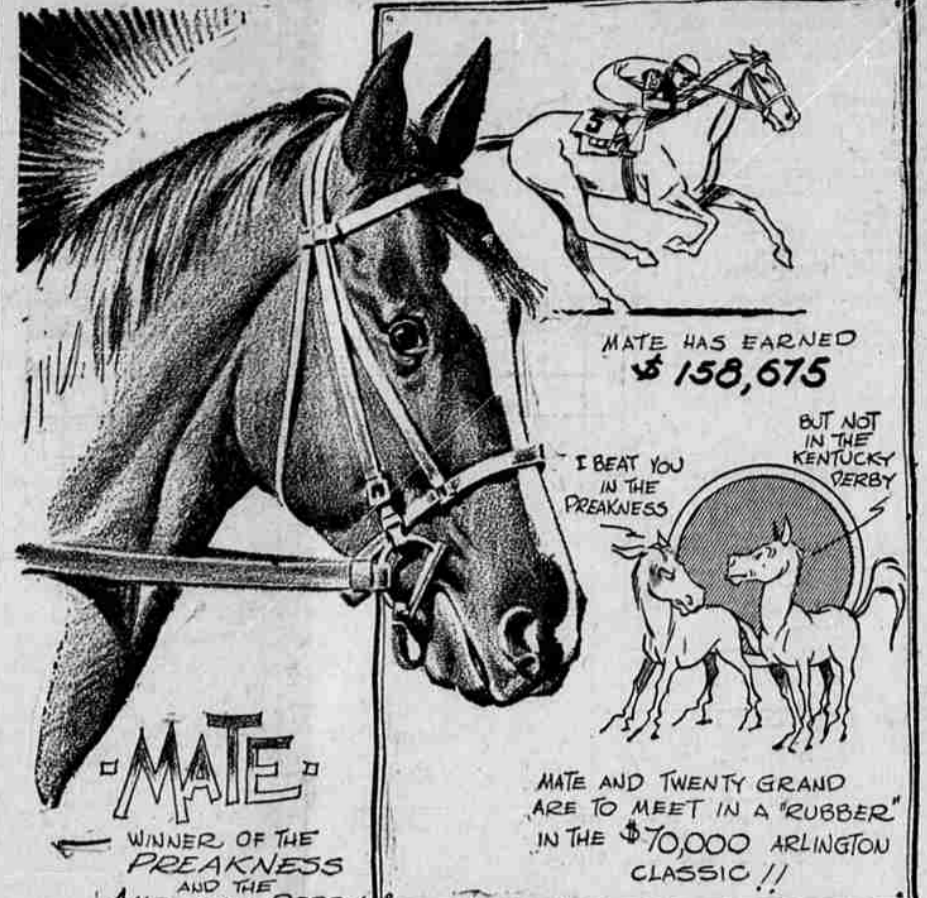
