**NO COUNTY FUNDS HELPING KINGSLEY ASSERTS COUNSEL**

Attorney Hanna Says Estimates of Expense Too Large—Rehearing Plea Will Be Filed Monday

Attorney Herbert K. Hanna, counsel for James E. Kingsley, convicted and confessed slayer of Sam G. Prescott, Ashland policeman last January said yesterday that the motion for a re-hearing of the supreme court would be filed with that judicial body next Monday. With Attorneys E. E. Kelly and T. J. Enright, he is working on the plea.

Attorney Hanna denies that the defense counsel has received any funds from the county for brief filing and other legal services and asserts that the estimates furnished the press are too large.

The defense plea for a re-hearing will be based, it is said, upon the fact that the supreme court bench failed to hold an unanimous view on the appeal, recently denied, and a re-argument on the contention of the defense, that remarks of the district attorney and his assistant in the closing arguments to the jury were prejudicial to Kingsley.

The statement of District Attorney George A. Coddling, that "the average term of a life prisoner is six and one-half years," and "a weak governor might pardon him," and the statement of Deputy District Attorney Geo. Neilsen, that "the defendant is as cold-blooded as a rattlesnake," are two objections registered by the defense.

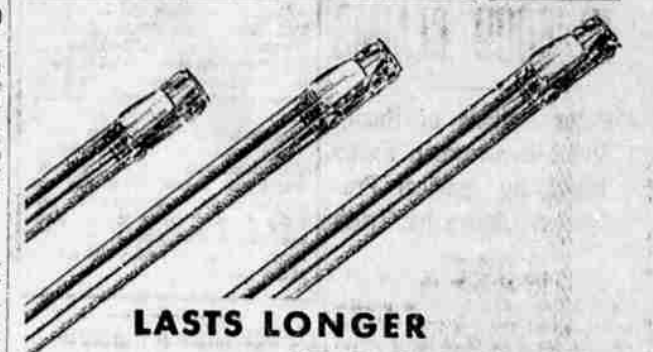
**TINY PORTLAND POWER PLANT WILL BE SOLD**
