

CRATE VITAPHONE ACTED 'QUEER' AS RESULT OF QUAKE

The earthquake shock felt in the Rogue river valley about 7:20 Sunday evening caused the vitaphone machine at the Fox Craterian theatre to fall to synchronize with the picture being shown on the screen. Archie Holt, manager of the theatre reported this morning. About 7:20 was the time given by Mr. Holt that the needle slipped about two grooves on the record, causing the machine to talk off time.

Operators were puzzled at the time as to the cause of the machine slipping, as the same records had been used in the midnight preview of "Politics," and the two afternoon showings, without any defects.

EL PASO, Texas, Aug. 18.—(AP)—Two earth tremors were felt today at Valentine, Texas, 100 miles east of El Paso. One occurred at 2:42 a. m., and the other at 1:37 p. m.

Residents fled to the streets for the second time in three days. In the Mexican quarter many persons gathered around churches and prayed for protection.

New cracks appeared in walls of houses already damaged in the earthquake which shook the town Sunday. Most of the houses are of adobe. No one was injured.

UNITED VETERANS TINGED WITH RED

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 18.—(AP)—Charging that certain leaders of the United Veterans' Employment league were in the paid employ of red communists, the commanders' council last night adopted a resolution denouncing the action of the league in filing suit against Multnomah county to compel employment of ex-service men in preference to others.

The commanders' council is composed of the heads of the Spanish-American war veterans, veterans of Foreign Wars, American Legion, and disabled American war veterans.

The commanders' council has definite knowledge that certain leaders of the so-called United Veterans' Employment league are now in the paid employ of red communists, the resolution said.

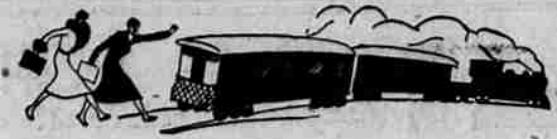
