

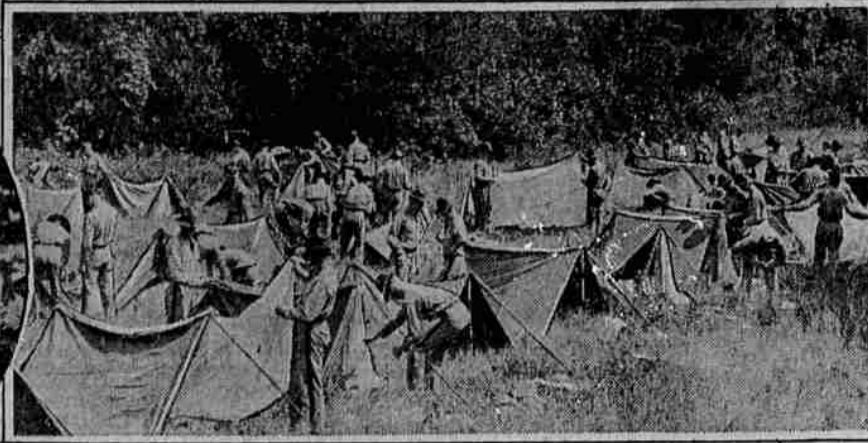
# CAMERAGRAMS

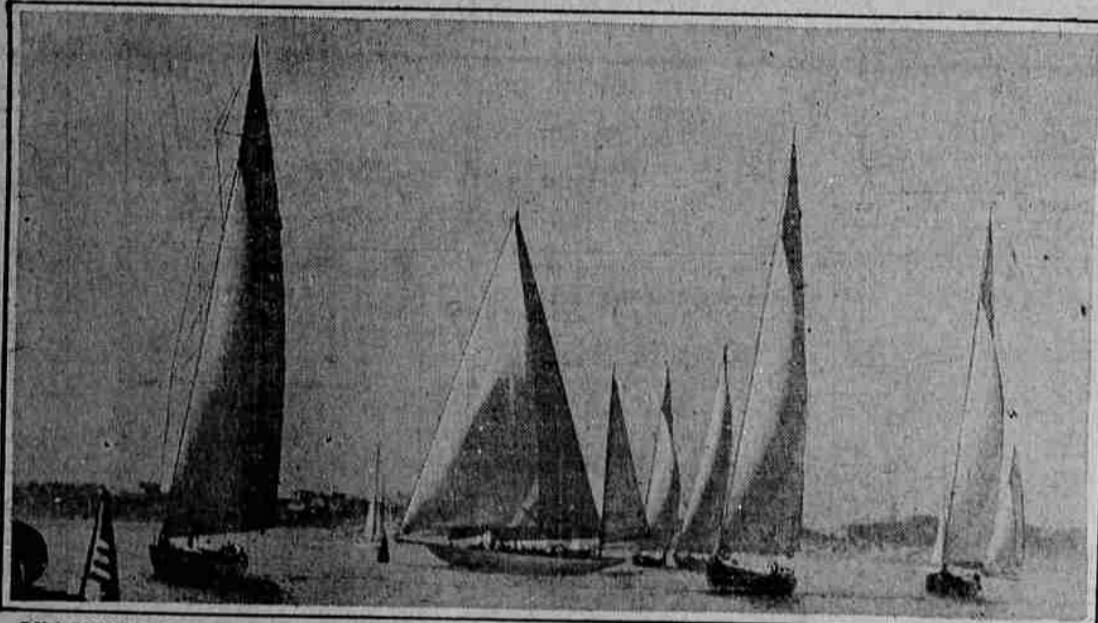

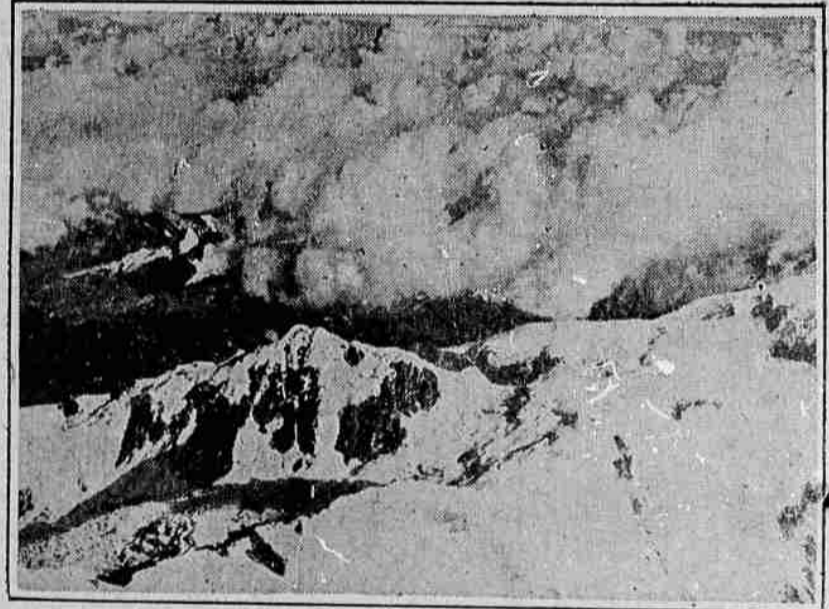

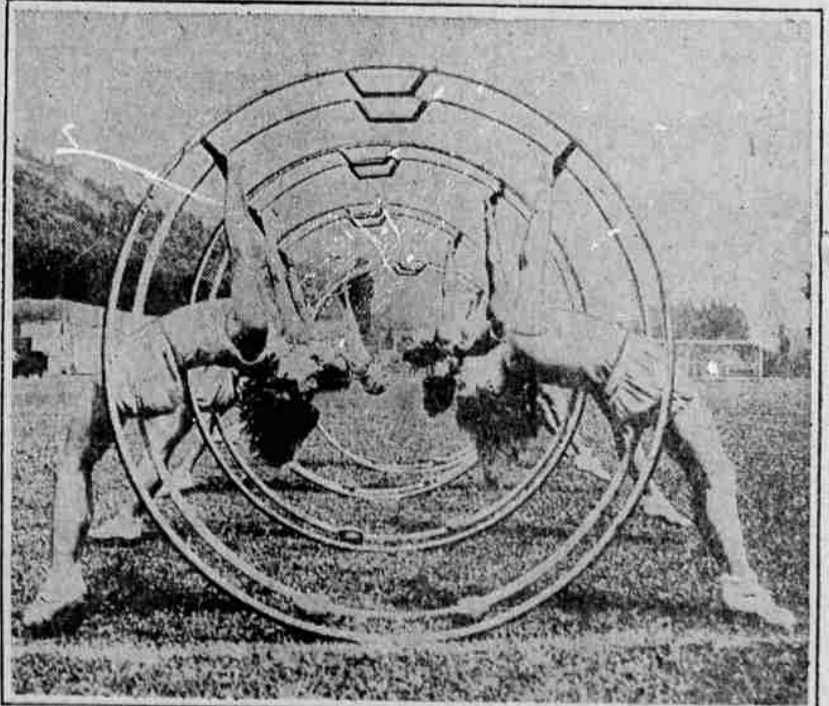
