

PEAR FOOD SHOW WILL BE FEATURE OF 4-H CLUB FAIR

A competitive display of foods, prepared with pears, will be featured at the School and 4-H club fair at the Jackson county fair grounds next week. It was announced this morning by representatives of local women's clubs.

Plans for the display were developed at a meeting of club presidents at the city library. It will be an all county display and the local group will work with Mrs. Mabel Mack, home demonstration agent, and other leaders of the county in presenting the show.

Pear pies, conserves, salads and all other pear products will be featured. Each display must be accompanied by the recipe and an extensive list of additional recipes is desired.

Several prizes will be awarded and all types of new dishes utilizing the pear are anticipated for the display. The directors of the Northwestern Fruit association feel that through the campaign now being carried on in Medford many recipes to be used in national advertising will develop. It was stated this morning. In view of this fact women are urged to originate and try out many recipes.

Entries for the pear show at the fair must be brought to the grounds before 10 o'clock Friday morning. The Parent Teachers association will serve a light lunch Friday and Saturday at the fair and will feature pears in the menus.

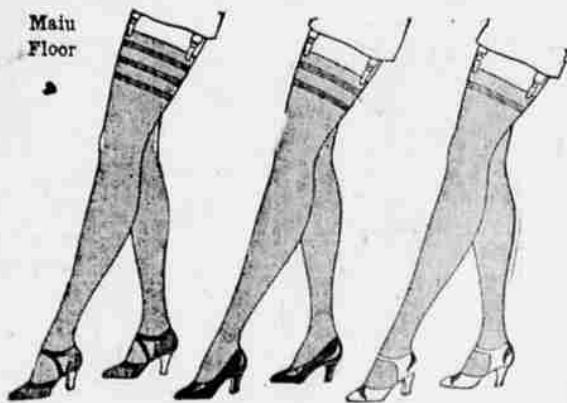
