## MEDFORD PEARS ARE ADVERTISED FOR EASTERNERS

Pears of the Rogue river valley and the pear producing sections of California and Washington, receive prominence this week in the public eye through the launching in New York City of the pear advertising campaign and the featuring of pears on the menus of the Missouri Pacific railroad, according to reports made at today's meeting of the Rogue River Traffic association.

The department of agriculture, the state of New York, and New York City also this week established a research bureau in Gotham, where data concerning the sale of pears, from the time it arrives, until it reaches the consumer, will be collected. The research will co-operate with the New York Pear committee of the valley shippers.

The Missouri Pacific lines, now feature pears, as a dainty in their dining cars, for breakfast, lunch and dinner. On the cover of the menu is a beautiful photograph of valley pears.

A section is devoted to special pear

dishes, prepared as follows: Fresh whole pears, baked pears, steamed pears, pear compote, fresh pear omelet, stuffed pears, pear fritters, deep dish pear pie, and pear glace, pear sundae, pear salad, and spiced pears.

On the front of the menu is also an article by John T. Stimson, director of agriculture development for the railroad, describing Pacific coast pears.

It was announced that the pear advertising campaign for winter varieties was getting underway in New York City, with a series of articles

in the Jewish press of that city, and other eastern centers.
