

### JACKSON COUNTY BOY DOING LONG TERM IN PRISON

A Jackson county boy has made good, in the prisons of California, according to information received by the sheriff's office from the identification bureau of the department of justice.

The information reveals that Clyde McGowan, who lived on a boy, and caused considerable trouble, is destined to serve from five years to life in San Quentin and 10 years in Folsom prison for first degree burglary. He was on parole from San Quentin when arrested for burglary in the Crescent City district, and California justice bore down heavily.

Records of Jackson county show that McGowan was in trouble several times over driving an auto without a license, speeding and moonshine operations, and that once when Deputy Sheriff Paul Jennings went to call him into court, he retired to the wilds of Griffin creek, later to come out and argue. He was sentenced to serve 30 days on a liquor violation charge. The authorities also allege that he transported stolen property from Del Norte to Jackson county, and vice versa.

McGowan, according to present indications will serve the next 15 years, less time off for good behavior.

### ROTARIANS PLANNING GOOD-WILL TRIP TO FAR EAST BROTHERS

The goodwill of Rotarians in the United States toward Rotarians in the Far East is to be expressed this summer by an International Rotary party which will sail from Seattle, June 25th, on the American Mail liner President Madison.

The party is to be led by Dr. and Mrs. Allen D. Albert, Doctor Albert having been international president of Rotary in 1910-6. It is expected by Mr. and Mrs. Paul B. Harris, Mr. Harris being the founder of the whole Rotary movement.

In Rotarian circles the feeling is expressed that this Oriental cruising party, while absolutely unofficial in character, will be the means of bringing about a closer understanding between the peoples of the eastern and western shores of the Pacific ocean. Rotarians in the Orient, all through the recent difficulties between Japan and China, have been endeavoring to pour oil on the troubled waters and to establish peace and reciprocity between the two great Oriental nations. Many cable messages of good will have been exchanged between the Rotarians of Japan and China.

### OREGONIANS HELD FOR MINE FRAUD

ST. LOUIS, Mo., April 22.—(AP)—Four men, three of them from Oregon, were held in jail here today on a charge of using the mails to defraud in promotion of a plan to consolidate two western mining companies.

They were Charles S. Klingman, 60 of Grants Pass, Earl McLaren, 40, and Joseph D. French, 69, both of Portland, and Robert E. Kremerer, 65, of Montreal, Canada.

C. J. Stettler, assistant United States district attorney, said the four planned to consolidate the Evergreen Mines company of Colorado and the Southwestern Smelting company of Nevada. The stocks of both companies, Stettler said, are practically worthless.

CORVALLIS, Ore., April 22.—(AP)—The Oregon State college co-ed debaters closed their season here last night with a double victory over teams from Whitman college on the subject of Nevada's divorce laws.

Later, Adena Joy of Ashland and Doris Rutherford of Los Angeles defeated Ruth Blain and Marjorie Douglass of Walla Walla by condemning the Reno practice as unsound and dangerous.
