BIG STEEL OMTS QUARTER DIVIDEND COMMON SHARES

NEW YORK, April 26.—(AP)—The U. S. Steel corporation today omitted a quarterly dividend on its common stock for the first time since 1915. Directors declared the regular quarterly dividend of \$1.75 a share on the preferred stock.

Omission of the common dividend had been widely expected because of decreased earnings. When a 50c payment was made three months ago, as reduced from \$1, the corporation said maintenance of disbursements on the junior shares must depend on a pickup in business.

NEW YORK, April 26.—(AP)—The stock market edged uncertainly higher in another sluggish session today. The market closed with numerous gains of fractions to more than 2 points, with a firm tone. Turnover approximated 800,000 shares.
