

CALIFORNIA EYES OREGON LAWS IN SAVING WILD LIFE

Californians are making a close study of the Oregon game code in order to improve their program for the conservation and propagation of wild life, according to Earl B. Gilmore, president of the Gilmore Oil company and member of the California game commission, who was a recent visitor in the northwest.

"Oregon has become nationally known as one of the finest states in the country for sportsmen," averred Mr. Gilmore. "No small amount of credit for this is due to the various sportsmen organizations and to the game commission who have adhered to the policy of protecting the wild life by propagation and game farms."

The oil executive, who is a noted huntsman and fisherman personally, pointed out that purely from a revenue standpoint, hunting and fishing is a big industry to California, as it is to other western states. He said that approximately a half-million licenses were sold there each year and the money obtained from this source, plus revenue derived from special game taxes, amounted to \$1,900,000 annually.

"Conservatively speaking, a c. h. sportsman spends an average of \$200 each year following the outdoor hobby which means that hunting and fishing, as a business, is worth \$100,000,000 to California," declared Gilmore. "If for no other reason, that feature has prompted us to study the Oregon program carefully and to sponsor the policy of building and operating bird sanctuaries and fish hatcheries."

Questioned concerning the possibility of future gasoline wars, Gilmore said that the country would always experience such untoward price situations from time to time until the law of supply and demand equalizes. He said that the same price situation pertains to lumber and food industries when the supply exceeds the demand.

Gilmore said that his concern was making a special effort at this time to protect the interests of the independent dealer. The Gilmore Oil company is, at the present time, supplying gasoline and motor oil to 8000 independent dealers on the Pacific coast and officials of the concern are constantly working with the dealers to enable them to operate the entire year at a reasonable profit.

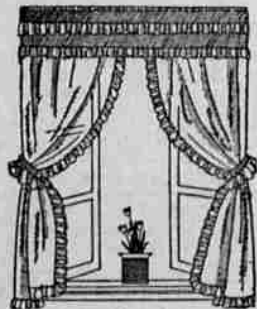

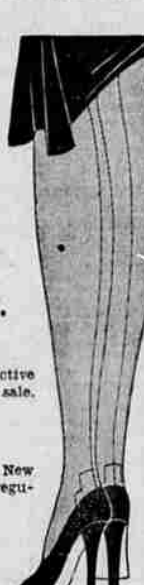
