

NIEDERMEYER IN MOVE TO AVERT PARR COLLECTION

Niedermeyer, Inc., this morning filed an amended complaint in their suit against the Pacific Record-Herald and its editor, Earl H. Fehl, and others, asking that the sheriff be directed to foreclose a chattel mortgage for \$6,443.98, and the property sold, as provided by law and further that the sheriff be restrained from the sale of the same property, under the execution of a \$15,000 libel suit judgment obtained by Roy Parr, game warden, Ashland.

The complaint further seeks that surplus of the sale, if any, after the satisfaction of the Niedermeyer, Inc., mortgage and legal costs, revert to Fehl and the Pacific Record-Herald. Niedermeyer, Inc., further asks that money allegedly owed them by Fehl be deducted from the chattel mortgage principal and interest. The complaint sets forth that Fehl performed labor over a period of 290 days for Niedermeyer, Inc., and that \$10 per day is a fair wage to pay. The total of \$2,900 they ask be subtracted from the chattel mortgage of \$6,443.98, which with other deductions, leaves a balance of \$4,004.94.

LARGEST ORDER FOR ENVELOPES LOCAL HISTORY

The "Mail Tribune" Commercial Printing Co., S. S. Smith, proprietor, recently placed the largest order for envelopes ever made by any firm in Medford or southern Oregon. There were almost one million envelopes in the order—973,000 to be exact—they weighed 10,000 pounds or five tons, and were purchased direct from the factory.

This large shipment was made possible by an order from the California-Oregon Power company for 730,000 envelopes. This order was placed by sealed bids and the local concern being the lowest bidder, was awarded the contract.

For years the local power company, like many other business institutions, has been using stamped government envelopes with a card printed in the corner. This year the company decided to discontinue the use of government envelopes and place their order with local printers. The only business the government is engaged in direct competition with is the printers, and it works a hardship on them. The printing of cards on the envelopes, by the government, is all alike, does not conform with the printed letterheads and it is impossible to have a cut or any other emblem printed on them.

Another reason for the change by the California Oregon Power company was the big saving in the price they paid the Mail Tribune Printing Co., from the government price on the envelopes. The Power company has purchased an electric mailing machine that seals the envelopes, affixes and cancels the stamps and handles them at the rate of 200 envelopes a minute. The saving in the price of the envelopes for the first year will enable the Power company to pay for their mailing machine.

Several orders for 10,000 to 25,000 envelopes were secured from other local concerns at reduced prices that were a part of the one million envelope order.
