

SCIENTISTS SEEK EXACT NUTRITION VALUE OF PEARS

Research work on pears is going on in several fields under the auspices of the Oregon-Washington Pear Bureau, according to David H. Rosenberg, president.

"This is the logical time to do research work—the first of the year of our program," says Mr. Rosenberg. "When we know the vitamin content of pears, work on which is going on at the Oregon Medical school, and the nutritional value, which is being investigated at the experiment station at Oregon State college, we have a basis upon which to build our advertising. This is particularly essential now, when housewives have to keep down the cost of meals yet at the same time want to keep the diet on a healthful basis."

In addition to the experiments on the physical properties of pears being worked out at the Oregon Medical school and Oregon State college, a test-out is underway in eight eastern cities to find out the public reaction to baked pears and pear pie. Through the International Steward Magazine, where the bureau has run some advertising this past season to further the use of pears in hotels and restaurants, a survey was arranged by the magazine. Ten boxes of pears were allowed each of the following hotels, who are to report their findings: The Statler hotels in Buffalo, Cleveland and Detroit; the Harvard Club, Boston; McMillan's, Chicago; Erie cafe, Philadelphia; William Penn hotel, Pittsburgh, and American-Annex hotel, St. Louis. The hotel in St. Louis has asked for an additional quantity, and is serving them at civic luncheons at the present time.

In Boston, the Harvard club spread the ten boxes furnished them among a number of hotels, including the Hotel Beaconsfield, John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance company restaurant, Hotel Statler, Algonquin club, Hotel Vendome, Engineers club, Chamber of Commerce restaurant, and Exchange club. Another Boston hotel became interested through an advertisement in the International Steward, and his written in for information. When all the data is gathered, the Steward's magazine will use it as the basis for an article.

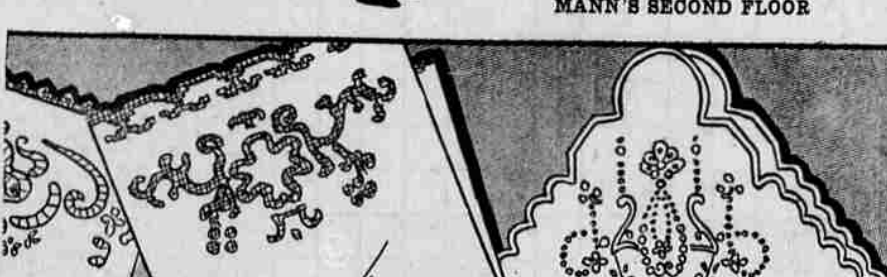
