SHANGHAI, May 27.—(P)—Forty persons were believed to be missing today from the river steamer Hing of the American Yangtze Rapids Steamship company. A report to the company said the boat struck a rock 233 miles above Ichang Wednesday and sank.

J. Anderson of Brooklyn, N. Y., captain of the boat, who made the report to the company here, was rescued and arrived today at Chungking, 115 miles above the scene of the wreck aboard a Chinese steamer.

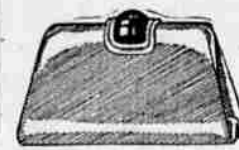
