HOPE TO PREVENT G.O.P. STAMPEDE FOR DRY REPEAL

WASHINGTON, June 15.—(AP)—Friends of the administration at the Chicago convention have sent word to the capital that they believe the Republican platform can be held to the prohibition question rather than a more drastic repeal plank.

The telephone line between Chicago and the White House was open during the morning and conversations were held by President Hoover's aides with various of the administration leaders in Chicago.

While all word of prohibition developments were withheld publicly at the White House, it was ascertained on high authority that optimistic reports have been received that a stampee for a repeal declaration could be averted.

It was declared last week in administration circles that the President would not raise serious objections to certain forms of resubmission of the prohibition question, but it was stated he would object emphatically to any repeal declaration by the convention.

White House aides today declined to say whether President Hoover had received the latest wording of the formula sought for solution of the prohibition question at Chicago, and all comment was withheld concerning his latest stand upon the question.

COLLEGE MERGER PETITION ARGUED

SALEM, June 14.—(AP)—Attacks on both the proposed initiative measure for physical changes in the state's higher education institutions and the ballot title prepared for the petition by the attorney-general were made before the Oregon supreme court today. Opponent of the initiative bill argued their appeal from the ballot title before five of the seven members of the court.

Included among those charging that the ballot title as prepared by the attorney-general is deceptive, prejudicial and argumentative was James Burdette of McMinnville, president of the Taxpayers Equalization league of the state of Oregon, who said that "the organization of which I am president is neither sponsoring nor supporting the measure which proposes to move the institutions of learning."

WASHINGTON, June 15.—(AP)—The senate banking committee Mon-

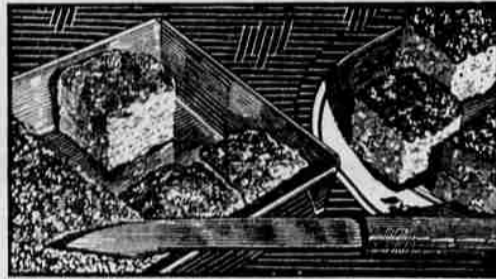
The home loan system would be capitalized with a maximum of \$125,000,000 from the government together with the sale of securities and subscription of stock by building and loan associations.
