## HAUSNER'S RESCUE FROM SEA'S GRIP TOLD BY SKIPPER

### Polish Flier Near Collapse When Taken From Plane—Unable Give Coherent Story of Experiences

S. S. CIRCE SHELL, June 15—(AP)—"I'm Stanley Hausner; save my ship."

With these words the Polish flier who had drifted miles on the Atlantic on his wrecked airplane greeted us when we found him.

He literally fell into the lifeboat which we had lowered to fetch him, and he was helped aboard my ship in almost complete darkness.

It was very difficult to see, but the lookout on the Circe Shell sighted something ahead. It looked like a drifting buoy, but he could make out some particular markings on the top.

### Airplane Recognized

He picked up the long glass and trained it on the subject. He saw then what he had thought was a buoy was really an airplane with its tail sticking up in the air.

Right away when he had told me what he saw I stepped to the engine room telegraph and signaled by engine order to cut the speed.

We slowed down and moved closer. We got to within one mile of the derelict and then I stopped the ship. We drifted and slowly closed in.

My men, watching from the rail, were amazed to see the figure of a man which seemed to be lashed to the machine.

We blew a blast on the ship's siren and the figure moved. He waved frantically. We could see now that he was not lashed down.

Right away I ordered a lifeboat away. It was manned by volunteers under my second officer.

### Rough Sea Running

From the bridge I watched them row away. When they were about 50 feet from the airplane they hailed him and the flier answered in English.

There was a rough sea running and it was getting worse and we were afraid the airplane might founder at any moment.

But my men were able to reach it in time to take off the exhausted aviator.

Almost all of my Chinese crew had gathered at the rail in the excitement to greet the unexpected flier when he was taken aboard.

It was then 45 minutes after the first sighting and night had fallen.

I endeavored to obtain a coherent statement from him as soon as he showed signs of revival, but his exhausted condition made this unfeasible.

### No Bad Injuries

Therefore, we contented ourselves with supplying Hausner with his immediate necessities of water and food. An examination revealed only superficial cuts, bruises and sores, all external injuries, and none of them serious.

At the time of my sending this radio the airman is progressing splendidly. He did not sustain any obvious internal injuries, but continues seemingly incapable of discussing his experiences.

It was amazingly fortunate we encountered him at the time we did, as by midnight the weather had turned hazy and four hours later a dense fog had set in. Even when he was first sighted, the barometer was falling, the sky was overcast and visibility was decreasing.

## FAIR POLITICIANS MAY CREATE STIR AT PARTY CONFAB

CHICAGO, June 15.—(AP)—In garb ranging from sober black to color splashed frocks, over 400 women—93 of whom cast a vote on a destiny shaping prohibition plank—gathered Monday in the steel-ratfink stadium for the formal opening of the Republican national convention.

Some were delegates with full voting powers; others alternates and still others spectators, some of whom had more party influence than many on the floor itself.

Among those last were Mrs. Dolly Curtis Gann and Mrs. Alice Roosevelt Longworth, both politically minded and both with brothers mentioned as vice-presidential possibilities.

The odds for the place favored Charles Curtis, the incumbent, and Mrs. Gann had already said with customary frankness that she thought he deserved the nomination again.

More, probably, than at any time since women were given the ballot voting, the delegates were given an unusual share of attention. Nobody expected any of them to startle uneasy party leaders, but there was an outside chance for feminist upsetting of well laid plans.

And at least one of those with the right to vote, Sarah Schuyler Butler, was prepared to give blow for blow on floor, if necessary, on the question which has received a tenacious net unlike most of the intra-party rows to the Democrats.

The comely daughter of the militant repealist, Nicholas Murray Butler, of New York, has served notice she will join in the scrapping with a vim if the resolutions committee stops short of a repeal proposal. She is a full-fledged delegate.

## YOUTH KILLED IN POOL HALL FIGHT

PORTLAND, Ore., June 15.—(AP)—An argument over a pool game culminated in a fist fight which ended fatally for David Gropp, 21, here last night. Al Fritzier, 22, was arrested and was held in jail on an open charge today pending investigation by police and the district attorney's office.

Police were told by friends of the youths they had come to blows in a pool room and, after being ejected by the proprietor, they agreed to go to an abandoned school playground and fight it out.

A group of young men followed the two and they told the police the fight seemed to be fair, although it was dark and they could not see distinctly. They said Gropp got up three times after being knocked down but was knocked unconscious by a fourth blow.

## DEMOCRAT RELIEF PLAN SUBSTITUTE FOR GARNER IDEA

WASHINGTON, June 15.—(AP)—The \$2,000,000,000 relief program offered by senate democrats was substituted today for the Garner \$2,300,000,000 plan by the senate banking committee.

The committee agreed to report the Garner bill with the provisions of the senate bill substituted, so that both measures can go to conference.

The action was the first step toward breaking the deadlock between house and senate on relief legislation.

The Garner bill carries \$1,200,000,000 for public construction, authorizes the reconstruction corporation to increase its capitalization by \$1,000,000,000 for construction loans; and creates an emergency fund of \$100,000,000 to be administered by the president.

The Wagner bill provides for a \$500,000,000 public works bond issue, to which President Hoover is opposed and authorizes an increase of \$1,500,000,000 in the borrowing power of the reconstruction corporation for loans for self-liquidating construction of a public nature.

## MORE TAXPAYERS ARE NEEDED IN AUSTRALIA

CANBERRA.—(AP)—Asserting there are not enough taxpayers in Australia, C. J. Carruty, federal auditor general, recommends that the government create some.

He argues that since only 265,000 of the country's 3,500,000 voters pay income taxes, the assessment should be levied on all who earn more than \$10 weekly.

This, he says, would make them realize the responsibilities of citizenship since many now vote carelessly because it costs them nothing to do so.
