EGAN AUTHOR OF ARTICLE ON GOLF IN RECENT ISSUE

An article by H. Chandler Egan, Medford's champion golfer, appears in the July issue of Game and Golf, national sports magazine. "You Are the Only Problem There is in Golf" is the title of the article, described as "a study in self-possessive psychology."

"Following the same line of thought," he continues to state, "I believe that most golfers would rather hit the ball cleanly and sweetly on proper line and have it end up many yards from the pin than dub one that by sheer accident dribbles dead to the hole."

The article, appearing at this very opportune time, when all local eyes are turned to Portland and Egan, has been given a prominent location in the magazine.

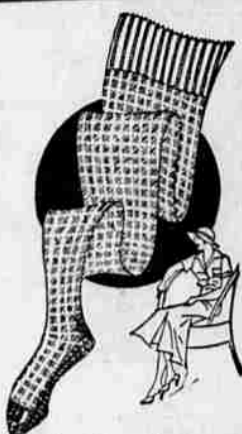
