

YOUNG AUTHOR IS IMPRESSED WITH OREGON SCENERY

Clasping the scenic wonders in Oregon that he has visited as "First-rate," Shelby Southard, 17-year-old author of Athens, Ala., arrived in Medford shortly before noon today from the Oregon Coast, on his tour through Oregon as a guest of "On to Oregon, Inc.," the result of a recent contest.

Southard won the trip to this state writing a 213-word article on "Why I Want to Spend My Vacation in Oregon," conducted through the American Boy, national youth publication.

"I think they brought me out here to see how much their literature underrated the state," the tall blond youth said, in referring to his 14 weeks' trip through the state. He spent four days at Seaside, enjoying the beach, and spent several days fishing the McKenzie and Deschutes rivers.

The biggest eastern brook trout he managed to capture was 15 inches long, he said.

"Nothing like fishing at home," Southard (who wishes people would please pronounce his name "Suthard") told A. B. Rosenbaum, who motored to the Oregon Coast to bring the boy here today. "They're all too sluggish back there, and it isn't any fun to pull them in."

Referring to his literary work, which he said it would be "impossible to escape," Southard told of the publication of his first book, to be out in October, "Saplings," being published by Garden City Press.

Southard writes adventure stories for boys, and is editor of "The Harversack," an eight-page Southern Methodist weekly, published in Nashville, Tenn. Practically all of his stories, which he has been writing since 12 years of age, have been sold to church publications, he said.

The young man did not credit his writing ability to personal genius, but to being acquainted with staff members of the publication, which allowed him to "slip under the ropes."

Having graduated from high school in May, Southard has not made up his mind if he shall continue to college, he said. He is considering enrolling at Emory college in Atlanta, Ga., a Southern Methodist school.

"I didn't get along so well in high school," he added, "because I wouldn't pay enough attention to it."

Southard was guest of the Lions club at regular meeting Wednesday, and left immediately afterward for Crater lake, with C. T. Baker, secretary of the local Chamber of Commerce, and J. C. Thompson. He spent last night at the lodge as the guest of the Crater National Park company.

Shippers Share Wildcat Truck Guilt Is Finding

SACRAMENTO, Cal., Aug. 11.—Holding shippers liable to punishment for misuse of the public highways in the transportation of freight, the California state railroad commission has unheated a new and powerful weapon in its fight to curb the activities of so-called "wildcat" truck operators, it was disclosed here today.

The commission's readiness at this time to exert its full authority by proceeding against those who "aid and abet" violations of the laws governing truck lines was declared emphatically in decisions finding five truck owners and companies guilty of operating without permits.

It was held, according to the announcement, that the truck owners in question were operating illegally as common carriers, in competition with certified motor lines and railroads. They were ordered to cease operations.

TROUT STREAM FOR WOMEN ONLY, PLAN
