IMPOSITIONS ON RELIEF AGENCIES WILL BE PROBED The attention of the county court and welfare workers of the county has been called to the following article, appearing in the last issue of the Central Point American: "And on this subject we want to say a few words concerning present-day activities for the aid of unemployment. Recently it has come to our notice that some families in our county are abusing the confidence of the Red Cross officials. We know of a certain family who have been obtaining Red Cross aid through gross misrepresentation. The head of the family has been working most of the summer as a skilled mechanic. One son has been working steady all summer. A daughter has been working part time. The family owns their home and have a large and beautiful garden. A short time ago the lady of the house went to the Red Cross and told them her husband was out of work, they had four children and just must have some flour. She got it, and the same day came home from town with a lot of new clothes, for which she had spent the husband's wages, and bragged of her exploit."

Commissioners Victor Burrell and John Barneburg said that the case would be investigated and, if the facts justified, suitable action would be taken. It will be the policy of the county court, this fall and winter, to take care first of local people, upon whom the stress of the times has fallen heavily, and not worry about transient indigents, lured to this county by erroneous reports that Jackson county was making preparations to "feed all comers."

The county court was also investigating reports from the north end of the county that there had been a recent increase of population, by transients preparing to winter in these parts and share in charity after a six months residence. Legal ways and means for placing a curb on the practice are being sought.

WALKER ARGUMENTS BEFORE HIGH COURT SUPREME COURT, Albany, N. Y., Aug. 23.—(AP)—Arguments upon which Mayor James J. Walker relies to obtain court intervention and halt his ouster hearing before Governor Roosevelt were laid before Supreme Court Justice Ellis J. Staley today.
