ANCIENT ARTISANS WORKSHOP FOUND IN SOUTH FRANCE

WASHINGTON, Sept. 8.—(AP)—Discovery of the site of a great Solutrian workshop in the foothills of the Pyrenees in southern France was announced today by the Smithsonian Institution.
