bridge-Portland, or a rate of \$0.049 per gallon of 6.6 pounds. In March, 1930, the switching charge was absorbed by the rails, making the rate \$0.099 per gallon. On May 3, 1931, rates to meet truck competition only and lower than would ordinarily be quoted, according to Henry's tariff, were established between Portland and various valley and coast points, effective only during the continuance of truck competition. The new rate to Medford, now effective, was 4 1/2 cents or \$0.231 per gallon, a reduction of \$0.123 from 1929."
