AMERICA LACKS REVOLT ARDOR, AVERS RUSSIAN Communist International Admits Little Hope for Plan in U. S. - Economic Crisis Was Main Lever

By Stanley P. Richardson MOSCOW (AP) - Taking new stock of the world status of communism, the Communist International acknowledges there is no "direct revolutionary situation" in the United States...

Only Hope in Workers "The stabilization of capitalism is at an end," says a resolution adopted at the executive committee's twelfth plenary session...

Describing the present time as a transitional period which will lead to collisions between classes and countries, the resolution outlined specific programs to be followed by communist parties in various countries...

Reviewing the world situation from the communist viewpoint, the resolution continues: "The revolution is going on. In China we have a revolutionary situation in the greater part of its territory...

"In Germany we have a sharpening of class antagonisms on one side the growth of fascism and on the other the growth of revolutionary mass struggle..."

"Some other countries also are approaching a revolutionary crisis, notably Poland; and we also may predict the same for Japan..."

"In India and Latin America a revolutionary crisis is prevented by the bad organization of the proletariat..."

"A constant, animated connection" between the communist parties and a majority of workers in every country is necessary, the resolution said...

"It is necessary to increase the bolshevik mass work and of workers' class," the committee said...

"The main problem of the comintern in all capitalist countries is to fight against capital, fascism and reaction, against advancing imperialism and intervention against the Soviet Union and destroy the mass influence exercised by social democracy..."

"These circumstances compel all union members to strengthen the defense of the socialist fatherland. Each militarized city, factory, collective and state farm must remind our enemies of the strength of the dictatorship of the proletariat..."

Notwithstanding this brilliant statement, the soviet government is less fearful of an armed attack on the U. S. S. R. now than for some time, due to the vast improvement of relations with Japan and the conclusion of a non-aggression pact with Poland...
