

### STANDARD'S OFFER TO BUY RICHFIELD GAINS ACCEPTANCE

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 11.—(AP)—Acceptance of the Standard Oil company of California terms of \$22,500,000 for the purchase of the Richfield Oil company properties today opened the way for the Standard company to strengthen greatly its position as a dominant factor in the west coast's oil industry.

G. Parker Toms, chairman of the bank creditors' committee, announced the acceptance of the Standard bid in behalf of the bank creditors, the Richfield bondholders and the unsecured trade creditors' committees.

"While the Consolidated Oil corporation offered \$23,000,000 debentures and 400,000 shares of common stock, the total of which at face value would represent about \$5,000,000 more than the face value of the Standard offer, the committee has been unable to set a positive value upon the Consolidated Oil corporation debentures because no market figures are available," said Toms.

"The committee felt it was to the best interests of all creditors they accept the Standard offer."

The Richfield company has been in receivership since 1930.

Young parents of today with their varied responsibilities are apt to neglect the stimulating contact with their children and this retards the first steps of character building.

The impulse to sentimentalize over our children should be conquered in its early stages as it only handicaps the child.

From infancy they should be taught the value of being able to make a decision and to be responsible for it.

The problem of keeping children happy has been solved by careful research. Books written on the subject of progressive education are to a great extent the result of teachers' observation in nursery schools, preparatory and primary grades.

Mothers all know that supervised play in school is more desirable than play at home. In the first place, family intermissions are avoided in school and children are regarded impersonally by the teacher.

The lack of personal ownership is of great importance because they learn to share school equipment.

Careful planning of space for work and play makes school a more orderly and peaceful environment for the child of primary years as well as the primary grades.

Young children are often overstimulated by trying to keep up with the older group. This necessitates a wise and thoughtful selection of constructive material and direction in its use is of vital importance.

Only a small percentage of families give enough thought to adequate play space which develops children mentally and physically.

Supervised play makes it possible to combine harmoniously the various ages of the children in the Valley school and the protected setting of this school is ideal.

The Friday assembly provides dramatic possibilities and a means to musical expression.

### City Budget Before Council on Tuesday

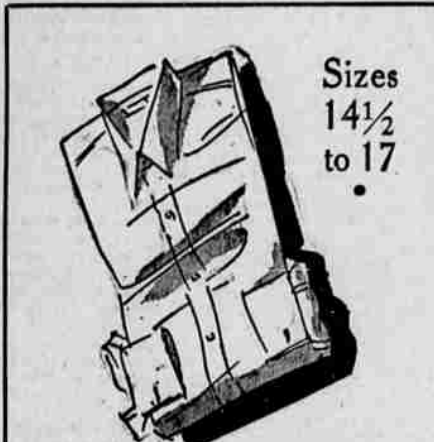
