

MRS. BARNUM IN PLEA FOR FUNDS IN DIVORCE CASE

Circuit Judge H. D. Norton returned this morning to the Jackson county bench after four days of hold-

ing court in Josephine county at Grants Pass. A number of routine matters, motions and demurrers were presented.

Mrs. Helen V. Barnum, through her attorney, Charles W. Beames, presented a motion and plea for the payment of and suit money by George A. Barnum as a result of a divorce action held last summer. Money for an appeal of the case to the supreme court is also sought. Barnum recently filed a plea that he was unable to make the monthly payments owing to depreciation of bonds and business.

Arguments were heard this morning in the case of D. C. Kunkler against Anderson Mee. A jury verdict upholding a mortgage is the issue. The court gave counsel five days in which to submit citations of law and briefs. An early decision was promised.

A demurrer filed in the damage action of Mrs. Manila Berdell against Mrs. Anna Wilkinson as a result of an alleged fight between the two women, was also argued. Mrs. Berdell alleges in her suit that, as a result of an argument, she was

beaten and injured. She seeks \$10,000 judgment.

The roads included Klamath Falls to California line, 17 miles; Dolp to Boyer, 5.16 miles; Tillamook to Banks via Wilson river, 33 miles; Pendleton to junction on Columbia River highway near Cold Springs, 30.5 miles; Albany to Sisters via South Santiam, 103.1 miles; Forest Grove to McMinnville, 23.4 miles; Fourth street entrance to Portland from West Side Pacific highway near Tligard, 4.2 miles.
