

SOUP KITCHEN STORY BRINGS OFFERS OF AID

C. S. Stuart of the Lions club stated today that wonderful response had been received by the organization following a report in last night's issue of the Mail Tribune concerning the soup kitchen being conducted for the unemployed here.

Mrs. Edwina Weishaar, president of the Business and Professional Women's club, said this morning that an effort was being made by the club to provide work for one of the three women depending upon the relief organizations.

Mrs. E. M. McKee last night provided quarters for one woman in order that she might have a place to stay.

Women of the Salvation Army congregation, co-operating with Capt. I. H. Gallahue, will try and furnish a room that might be used for local transient women who have no place to stay, according to announcement today.

The sleeping quarters provided at the present time are only for men.

Relief workers are anxious that some plumber volunteer his services in order that drinking water might be provided in a sanitary way for the sleeping room.

other debtors, President Hoover stated that no reasons had been advanced to justify suspending the December 15 payments.

He added that he would recommend to congress the formation of an agency to go over the whole situation with the debtor nations.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 2. — (AP) — Strong sentiment against further deferment of European war debts was expressed on Capitol Hill today, as legislators read the lengthy British note of yesterday urging relief from this month's payments and President Hoover studied a similar communication from France.

Senator Smoot of Utah, Republican chairman, and Harrison of Mississippi, ranking Democrat on the senate finance committee, were warmly critical of the British statement that increased tariffs and restrictions against American goods would be necessary if payments were resumed.

Others who read the British note inclined to rather general belief that the United States would again deny the requests for leniency at this time.

"If Great Britain desires to carry out the plan suggested," said Smoot, "she has a perfect right to do it, but in my opinion she will be the sufferer instead of the United States."

Representative Hawley of Oregon, ranking Republican on the house ways and means committee, said: "So far as the British note is concerned I am still of the opinion that all the nations ought to pay us on the date due."

suit, and "to inflame and arouse public opinion against the plaintiff."

Following the decision of the court, in the demurrer, Attorney M. O. Wilkins, counsel for Banks, declared in court that the morning paper was ready to tender to the court the \$450 allegedly due to Hubbard. The court instructed him to make the tender at the afternoon session.

Many Cases Cited.

This morning, Attorney Wilkins made an argument citing numerous cases in support of his contention that the demurrer should be sustained.

The court, in its ruling, held that the claim of the defense that the complaint encroached upon the federal bankruptcy laws was not well taken, and that other contentions had no legal merit. The court held that the laws of Oregon and other states were plain in detailing the powers and meaning of the laws.

The court complimented the defense counsel upon the thoroughness of his arguments.

A fairly well-filled courtroom listened to the proceedings.
