

# Pop Warner Resigns as Stanford Grid Mentor for Eastern Post

## DISSATISFACTION CAUSES TRANSFER TO TEMPLE FLAG

Maker of Famous Teams Confirms Rumors Rife for Some Time—Sees Opportunity Philadelphia College

STANFORD UNIVERSITY, Cal., Dec. 5.—(AP)—Glenn S. "Pop" Warner, Stanford football coach, announced today he had submitted his resignation to Dr. Thomas A. Storey, director of athletics.

At the same time the veteran coach announced he had received a contract from Temple university, Philadelphia, and would be there to take charge of practice next spring.

Warner disclosed he had received a similar offer from Temple last year but had elected to remain at Stanford.

Warner comes to Temple he would succeed Henry J. (Heinie) Miller, former University of Pennsylvania star, who has been head coach since 1924.
