**REBECCA MOORE OF CENTRAL PT. CALLED TO REST**

Rebecca Ann Robinson Moore passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Minnie M. Clark, of Central Point, Ore., at an early hour Friday morning after an illness covering one and one-half years. She was born at Springfield, Utah, July 29, 1857. April 16, 1876, she was united in marriage to Andrew E. Moore at San Bernardino, Cal., where they made their home until 1882, in which year they came to eastern Oregon, and in 1884 removed to Jackson county, having lived here continuously for 49 years.

She was a fine Christian woman, wonderful mother and loving wife, living only for her aged husband and children. They celebrated their 56th wedding anniversary last April. Mrs. Moore leaves her husband and six children, one daughter, Mrs. Angeline Snyder, having passed away last July. Those who survive are: Husband, Andrew Moore; daughters, Mary J. Rummel, Medford; Minnie M. Clark, Central Point; sons, Stephen A. Moore and Joseph C. Moore, both of Medford; George R. Moore, Central Point; Seuben E. Moore, Prospect, Ore., and also 11 grandchildren and five great grandchildren. She was a member of the Christian church. Funeral services will be conducted from the First Funeral Home, Saturday at 2:30 p. m., Rev. W. R. Baird officiating. Interment in the Central Point cemetery.

**SHELLEY DRESSED IN AT STATE PEN**

W. R. Shelley, former Medford really agent and religious worker, convicted of a statutory offense against his own daughter, this week begins serving a 23 year sentence in the state prison. Shelley was taken to the penitentiary last Monday. His hope to spend Christmas outside the walls was blatted, when the court ruled that he should be confined at Salem pending a decision in his plea for new trial.

The accusing daughter is now living in southern California. The wife and 16 year old son are in Portland. Shelley was fairly well-known in this city and county and in 1929 started the Pitt View sub-division, upon which he erected a number of houses. Later he became legally involved in this project. At one time, Shelley gave religious talks over the radio and was more or less active in local political affairs in a small way. He moved from this city to Oregon City and Bascada, in Clackamas county, where he continued his religious and real estate work. A number of local people were called as witnesses in the case and there was considerable interest here in the outcome.
