THREE CLEAR DAYS SHOWN IN JANUARY WEATHER RESUME

Meteorological notes for January, as compiled by W. J. Hutchinson, local meteorologist, show the month was characterized by a predominance of cloudiness and frequent rain and snow storms.

During the first part precipitation, entirely in the form of rain, occurred almost daily. The greatest 24-hour amount for the month fell on the 2nd and 3rd, totaling 1.03 inches.

Temperatures, both maximum and minimum, averaged several degrees below normal. However, there were no unusually low temperatures recorded.

Weather for the month was mostly unfavorable for aircraft operation. Changeable conditions with squally weather frequent and with numerous periods of valley fog and upper air at times favorable for ice formation on aircraft combined to disrupt considerable air traffic.
