PARIS-(AP) A sparkling diamond brooch has supplanted all other jewels in the favor of the smart set.
Earrings and necklaces stay at home in the gem box, while one radiant jewel gleams from the neck or waistline of both day and evening gowns.
Brooches nestle in the sidepockets of a draped neckline, in the point of a V-neck on the front of a bodice. They are caught on the left shoulder of little ermine cape, poised on the shoulder straps of an evening gown or fastened to the back strap of a decollete, while clips appear in every conceivable corner from necklines and belts to the brim of a hat.
Diamonds are the favorite jewel for these brilliant brooches and clips, although rubies, emeralds and sapphires are occasionally set into the design.
A round brooch, in the newest design, although rectangles, triangles and hollow squares are a favorite with smart Parisians. Both baguette and cut diamonds of moderate size are used.
A V-shaped diamond clip is used by Patou to accent the V-decollete of the black crepe dinner gown shown at right. Diamonds are the favorite jewels, but other gems also are seen in the new brooches which are equally smart for day or evening gowns.
