Al Smith Favors Public Building Program to Put Unemployed Men in Jobs

Condition Akin to War Confronts Country Is Warning to Senate Committee Sever Red Tape Is His Advice

WASHINGTON, Feb. 28.—(AP)—Alfred E. Smith expounded to the senate finance committee yesterday his insistence on enlarged public construction as a spur to business.

"Cut out all the red tape," he advised, "and go back and build buildings like we did in the twenties."

Smith urged that Reconstruction corporation interest rates on construction loans be cut to four per cent, and especially called for speeding up of highway work.

"I don't know any reason for not doing it," Smith said regarding recognition of Russia. "There's no use trading with them under cover, we are doing business with them through the Amtorg Trading corporation."

Smith said he favored giving the executive a veto, adding: "I am not in sympathy with all this talk about dictators, monarchs and kings when you give the president power to run the government as a private undertaking."

Turning to the railroads, Smith predicted a time when there will be a consolidation of all the railroads.

"It will be a consolidated transportation system of all carriers," he said. "The railroads have been talked of as the arteries of the nation for so long they think they can carry through great big capital structures."

Smith looked on the proposed four system consolidation plan advocated two or three years ago "as the beginning of a consolidation such as I have suggested."

MINNEAPOLIS, Mar. 1.—(AP)—A commission which declared the profession had been "mex long enough" urged American educators today to go on the warpath against those who "would make children the victims of the depression."

A fighting campaign for public support in ferreting out the attackers, directed by a commission already set up, was advocated in a report presented to the department of superintendence, National Education association.

So serious did the executive boards of the department and the association, parent body, deem the crisis caused by fund reduction that they ordered the continued indefinitely the joint emergency commission which made the report. That group, of which John K. Norton of Columbia university is chairman, was created in January.

Attempt to Cripple System. At the same time the lay committee of the department, functioning as a liaison agency between the profession and the public, charged in a report today there appeared to be an organized attempt "by those who control great wealth to cripple the public school system of America."

"This attack," said the lay committee, "is the more insidious because by its subtle propaganda it enlists thousands of harassed taxpayers in leagues militantly organized and committed to the task of betraying the best interests of their own children."

No organization or individuals were named. Rather, the committee said, its statement of "organized attack" was directed in a general way to forces seeking tax reduction.
