## TOMATO GROWERS URGED TO ATTEND WEDNESDAY MEET

All interested in the growing of tomatoes and tomato plants in the Rogue River valley are urged to attend the public meeting in the auditorium of the court house Wednesday at 2 p. m.

Dr. Frank P. McWhorter of the Oregon State agricultural college will be present to give growers some valuable information regarding the blight or spot disease that has been threatening the tomato industry in southern Oregon. Dr. McWhorter made several inspections and investigations of conditions here last year, and the college, in conjunction with the county agent's office and Prof. F. C. Reimer of the Southern Oregon Experiment station, are making a concerted effort to control this condition. Local commercial canners and greenhouse operators are also co-operating in the movement.

It is very essential that every care and precaution be exercised to combat and control this disease and thus conserve an important and growing industry in this part of the state. Ralph E. Kooser, manager of the Bagley Canning company, advises that they were careful in treating all their tomato seed this year to eliminate the possibility of any seed borne infection and that due precaution will be continued, to avoid, if possible, unnecessary contamination from kindred plants.

In view of the importance of this condition, Mr. Kooser stated that this is a matter that vitally affects all tomato growers in the district as well as those indirectly interested in the industry and expressed the hope that all growers, whether rais-
