**THREE PAY STATE
IN ELECTRIC CHAIR**

McALESTER, Okla., May 5.—(P)—Three men paid the state with their lives early today for two slayings and a robbery.

In Oklahoma's first triple execution since 1928, Joe L. Martin, 33; Proctor McDonald, 23, and Albert Ellis, 25, were put to death in the electric chair at the state prison here.

Martin, a blacksmith, who killed Pete Von Nearop, a Hollander, last July because, he said, Von Nearop "caused the United States" broke down in the death chamber, talking excitedly until the death current was sent into his body.

McDonald was condemned for the fatal shooting of Raymond Butler, eight-year-old son of an Olton druggist, in an attempted holdup, and Ellis for the robbery with firearms of the family of John Weber, Port Worth, Texas, broker, on a highway.

**PRISON GOODS BAN
REMOVAL SOUGHT**

WASHINGTON, May 5.—(P)—Alabama asked the supreme court today to declare invalid federal and state laws under which sale of Alabama prison-made goods is prohibited.

Alabama requested that the 19 states of Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Montana, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Washington and Wisconsin and the United States be made defendants. All ban or require branding of prison goods, which Alabama claims is infringement of its rights and powers as a sovereign state.

**MRS. PINCHOT JOINS
SWEATSHOP PROTEST**

ALLENTOWN, Pa., May 5.—(AP)—Mrs. Clifford Pinchot, wife of the governor of Pennsylvania, today threw her lot with "child workers" protesting "sweatshop" conditions in the garment industries.

Dressed in red, she joined picket lines of teen-aged girls and boys who have walked out of textile plants because they say they get as little as 87 cents a week.

**TEXAN IS CHAIRMAN
OF R. F. C. DIRECTORS**

WASHINGTON, May 5.—(AP)—Jesse H. Jones of Houston, Texas, a director of the reconstruction corporation, today was chosen chairman of the board by other corporation directors. He succeeds Allee Pomerene, Cleveland attorney, whose appointment by President Hoover was not confirmed by the senate. Pomerene automatically went out of office March 4.
