FIVE CENT LOAF GOES AS WHEAT PRICES RISE

BALTIMORE, July 7.—(AP)—Baltimore baking companies officials today met an increase in the price of flour by abolishing the five-cent loaf of bread and reducing the size of the seven-cent and ten-cent loaves.

NEW YORK, July 7.—(AP)—Stocks surged through a 7,000,000 share market today to an irregular closing after a strenuous early rise of 8 1/2 to 54.

With the dollar dropping to 70 cent valuation as measured by gold currencies, speculative pulses beat wildly, especially on the stock exchange where the tape fell as much as 26 minutes behind. Volume was one of the largest of the past three months. Wheat and corn, after rising 1 to 2 cents, finished with losses of equal extent.
