

WHEAT GROWERS TOLD BENEFIT IN REDUCTION PLAN

Contract Signers Will Receive 20 Cents Bushel On Allotments in Fall, 8 to 10 Cents Next Spring

CORVALLIS, Ore., July 28.—(AP)—Oregon wheat growers who sign federal wheat adjustment contracts will receive payment of 20 cents a bushel on their allotments this fall, and from 8 to 10 cents a bushel additional next spring, according to definite word received by the Oregon State college extension service today.

County allotments based on 84 per cent of the 3-year acreage production have been worked out at Washington, D. C., it was said in a message received from the capitol, and Oregon's list of allotments are being forwarded.

To Announce Cut This was the first definite announcement as to the size of the allotments on which benefit payments will be made, and the first word as to the exact proportion of the benefit payments to be made this fall.

There is but one major decision to be announced. That is the exact amount of acreage reduction to be required in return for the benefit payments, but it is known the reduction will not be more than 20 per cent, State college experts said.

To Proportion Curb Individual allotments will be fixed by the county organizations soon to be set up by the growers themselves. Once the national wheat administration fixes the county allotment, it depends on local organization to make the distribution equitable, it was explained here.

The 30 cents a bushel processing tax now in operation is estimated to yield \$138,000,000 on the 460,000,000 bushels taxable as domestic consumption for human food, advice received by the extension service said. Of this sum, approximately \$90,000,000 will be available for distribution this fall.

SONS AUDITORIUM ECHOES BANISHED

Acoustics of the Southern Oregon Normal auditorium are being improved by Angus L. Bowmer, director of dramatics, so that in the future it will be easier for audiences to hear.

Sounds echoing in the dome of the room have made it difficult at times to hear the voices of actors on the stage. By stretching steel wires across the ceiling, Professor Bowmer hopes to eliminate much of this resounding.

Instead of reverberating in the dome, the sound waves will be caught and muffled by the wires, about six of which will probably be necessary in order to eliminate the echoes.

Professor Bowmer is now experimenting with the placement of these wires in order that the auditorium will be in good condition for the presentation of the four-act comedy "Grumpy" on August 5.
