

HIGH GRADE EGGS HEAR ONLY CALL IN PORTLAND DEAL

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 4.—(AP)—Everywhere graded prices were suggested in the market for eggs except perhaps for limited lots of extreme quality. Owing to the fact that Portland was today quoting the highest price along the coast, there was no shipping call whatever except where concessions were made.

Cold storage stock, selling as strictly fresh goods, keeps the volume of supplies rather liberal. Price cutting by some retailers, at times selling below actual cost, was a factor against the market.

Receipts continued to increase with the chief gain in pullet size, which were difficult to move owing to the very small differential between such offerings and the largest eggs.

Tomatoes showed a somewhat better tone for the day. Demand for The Dalles stock was very liberal during the day, resulting in a general cleanup of supplies with a slightly better price in spots up to 60 cents.
