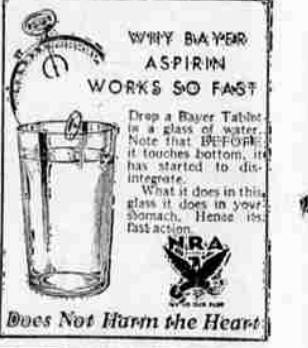
BABY CLINIC SLATED THURSDAY AFTERNOON
