

# FORECAST COLD DRY WINTER 'ON PACIFIC COAST

Precipitation Cycles and Sea Temperatures Used in Making Forecast — Cold Like 1921-22 Indicated

LA JOLLA, Cal.—(UP)—A cold, dry winter was forecast for the Pacific coast during the coming season, upon the basis of studies by the Scripps Institution of Oceanography here.

In the institution's forecast, particular attention was paid to five natural rainfall regions in California and two in Oregon, not including the eastern slopes, but representing a variety of elevations, distances from the coast and latitudes ranging from San Diego to Portland.

Precipitation cycles and sea temperatures were used in making the forecast. The institution's report said:

"The long cycle of about 25 years is now rising to a crest, due probably before 1940. However, while the general trend in precipitation may be upward, more reliable indications for one season should follow from the prominent short five-year cycle and the difference between the late summer sea surface temperature and that of the previous winter.

"A study has just been made of how these two factors, working together, have influenced the seasonal rainfall in the past at each of the selected regions. Although the temperature relation itself points to a moderate excess, this is the low point in the five-year cycle, which factor appears to dominate.

"Accordingly, all of the evidence points to less than average precipitation during 1933-34 at all of the regions and even less than that of last season as well, except in the Santa Barbara and Huntington lake areas. The values of the seasonal precipitation thus calculated range from about 60 per cent to 85 per cent of the average.

"During the next three months abnormal temperatures may be expected, but the estimates indicate differences less extreme than were experienced during the summer. In general, a temperature trend toward that of the 1921-22 season is indicated."

The institution recalled its forecast issued last October, which predicted less precipitation than during the previous year, and found its conclusions to have been borne out.

## V. F. W. RALLY FOR PENSION RETURN STARTS NOV. 6TH

Each member of Crater Lake Post 2683, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, has been appointed a "committee of one" to obtain 400 new recruits. This plan, devised by Commander Canfield, will result in an increased local membership of 400 as a contribution to the nationwide V. F. W. veterans' defense rally to be sponsored by that organization between November 6th and June 30th, 1934.

In announcing the campaign plans for the local V. F. W. units at a special meeting held November 1, at Eagles Hall, Commander Canfield told the members the veterans' defense rally was conceived by newly elected Commander-in-Chief James E. Van Swinderen as the best step in a major counter-attack against the forces that obtained passage of the economy act during the last session of congress.

"Our post quota has been assigned 34 by National Chief of Staff A. D. Vandervoort," Commander Canfield told the members. "Similarly, definite quotas have been assigned each post and each state department throughout the country. Filling these quotas will put in our hands a weapon of great potential strength and power with which to combat those anti-veteran forces which sponsored the economy act.

"It is up to the Veterans of Foreign Wars and other veteran groups to join together for the purpose of repealing this iniquitous act. It is our job—unless we do it, it will not be done. We know, more surely than anyone else can know, of the trag-

edies and privation caused by the so-called economy act—or the injustices done to men who sacrificed their health and their future for their country."
