

### CHICAGO GRAFTING EXPOSED IN PROBE OF INCOME TAXES

#### Bourbon Boss of 24th Ward Split Huge Sum With Politicians, Is Claim Made in Newspaper Article

CHICAGO, March 13.—(AP)—The evening American, in a copyrighted story, today said Moe Rosenberg, Democratic boss of Chicago's 24th ward before his death last January, had made a statement to the United States government of how he split an enormous income with Chicago Cook county and Illinois county politicians.

The statement, said to have been made at an income tax fraud hearing in Washington last December 27, told of his contributing approximately \$500,000 to politicians and office holders, most of them Democrats.

His sole income, Rosenberg said in a sworn statement, was from the Rosenberg Iron and Metal company, a junk concern.

One of the largest recipients of his doler, Rosenberg swore, was the late Mayor Anton J. Cermak of Chicago. The total sum given Cermak was \$95,000, he said.

Rosenberg's statement said he got 90 per cent of all the utility junk business in Cook county and all the junk business from the Illinois Bell Telephone company in the state of Illinois.

The junk dealer's story to the investigators was that he got the business by going to see Samuel Insull himself and "talking turkey."

Whenever a bill unfavorable to the utility interests came up at Springfield, Mo. related, he would visit his strong boxes in the loop, "take something down to the capital," and the bill would die a natural death.

### DIVORCE MADE EASY UNDER NEW LAW OF MEXICAN PROVINCES

NEUVO LAREDO, Mex.—(UP)—Neuvo Laredo and the state of Tamaulipas are bidding for distinction as the divorce headquarters for marriage-weary husbands and wives of the United States and Mexico.

Under laws newly enacted an uncontested divorce decree may now be procured in a single day—without the necessity of appearance of either party to the action, according to the Mexican Divorce Institute.

If the suit is opposed by the husband or the wife, it may take as long as two weeks to obtain the end sought by the plaintiff.

Under a new Tamaulipas law, marriage is a civil contract. If both parties want to break it, says the law, there is no occasion for questioning their right to do so. The divorce is granted forthwith.

If one party to the contract objects to its breach, various causes may be successfully cited: These include physical incapacity, dishonorable conduct, cruelty, incorrigibility, absence, intemperance, and ineffectuality.

The objecting party may appear or file an answer through attorneys, but he encounters a psychology which opposes the enforced continuance of a marriage which is distasteful to either member of the union.

To bring a case before the Mexican court here, it is but necessary that a copy of one's marriage certificate be filed and proper powers of attorney be given any attorney entitled to practice in Tamaulipas.

JACKSON, Miss., March 13.—(AP)—Three negroes will be hanged Friday; but the father of the white girl they attacked will not be their hangman if one Mississippi legislator has anything to do with it.

"There will be no legalized butchery in this state," said Walter Sillers, chairman of the judiciary committee of the house of representatives.

The state senate has passed a bill which would make it possible for Clyde Collins, father of the white girl, to act as hangman for her attackers. The "negrohanging bill" has been referred by the house to Representative Sillers' committee. Sillers pocketed the bill yesterday and stated committee until after Friday — the there would be no meetings of his execution day.
