

ELKS' GRAND RULER BREAKFAST GUEST ON MEDFORD VISIT

Walter F. Meier of Seattle, Wash., grand exalted ruler of the Elks, and official party composed of Frank J. Lonergan of Portland, grand forum member; C. C. Bradley of Portland, district deputy grand exalted ruler, north; and O. L. McDonald of Salem, district deputy grand exalted ruler, south, were guests at a breakfast given this morning in the Hotel Medford by the Medford lodge of Elks.

The party left this morning for Grants Pass and Roseburg, and appeared at a meeting last night of the Ashland lodge of Elks when 42 new members were initiated.

"Elks can know with pride, that our President is an Elk, and that a practical application of many of the ideals for which Elksdom stands is now being made," Grand Exalted Ruler Martin said in a short address. "Elksdom has long striven to make the world a better place in which to live, to keep alive the fires of neighborliness, to give every man a better life, and more time in which to enjoy it and to spread the gospel of happiness and good cheer."

The grand exalted ruler stated that in his visit to the Elks lodges of the nation, he had found a friendly feeling and a better spirit.

Following the initiatory work and address by the grand exalted ruler, a fine lunch was served by the Ashland lodge.

DOGS BITTEN BY RATTLESNAKES

Two dogs were taken to the Rogue small animal hospital yesterday suffering from rattlesnake bites, and a warning was issued today by the Jackson County Humane society that precaution should be taken against the snakes, now coming out because of the warm weather.

It was pointed out that if the dogs are brought in soon enough, a cure can be effected without the use of anti-toxin, which is the same as used for humans. One of the dogs was brought into the hospital yesterday only 30 minutes after it had been bitten, and was saved.
