

### NORMAL SCHOOL SUMMER SESSION OPENS JUNE 8TH

Pres. Redford Announces Six Weeks' Session and Special Two Weeks' Session — Instructors Listed

ASHLAND, May 11.—(Sp.)—The regular summer session of the Southern Oregon Normal school will open Monday, June 18, and will last for six weeks, it was announced here today by Walter Redford, president of the school, and Alfred Powers, dean of the general extension division for the state system of higher education. Courses, all to be taught by experienced and expert faculty members, will be offered in art, economics, education, history, library, music, penmanship, physical education, psychology, science and sociology. A special session, to last two weeks, will be of unusual value also, it is pointed out. At this time, courses will be offered in study helps, primary teaching aids, literature, contemporary drama, health education, music education and physical education. Courses in this session will be taught by the following instructors:

Hobson, physical education; Loren E. Messenger, psychology; R. W. McNeal, Wayne W. Wells, science, and A. C. Strange, sociology.
