

## Joint Ben Ali-Hillah Shrine Ceremonial In This City Saturday

### BEN ALI WILL CONDUCT WORK IN CEREMONIAL

Golf Tournament and Valley Trip Planned — Colorful Parade Follows Banquet — Ceremonial in Armory

Tomorrow morning at 8 o'clock, 400 happy Californians will roll into the Southern Pacific depot in Medford for the most colorful Shrine gathering in the history of southern Oregon. Ben Ali's fezzed nobles, led by illustrious Potentate W. P. Neville, will spend 18 hours of joyous good-fellowship in Hillah Temple's domain as guests of the southern Oregon Shriners, marking another epoch in the history of close friendship between the Sacramento nobles and those who wear the Hillah fez.

And Hillah Temple is ready for their welcomed visitors... prepared to pack the 18 hours with fun and frivolity. Nearly half of Hillah's membership has had a hand in the preparations for the joint ceremonial with Harold Brown heading the many committees that have been active for the past two months.

The program of entertainment for Ben Ali Shriners will begin with a breakfast in the main floor dining rooms of the Hotel Medford immediately following the arrival of the trains and march to the hotel. After the breakfast, those who bring their

noble and masher will be whisked to the beautiful Rogue Valley golf course where a Shrine tournament will be staged. For the visitors who prefer other entertainment, a drive through the Rogue River valley has been planned, ending at the historic old city of Jacksonville, rich in the romance of the '50s. Here the two museums will be visited, the historic old Jacksonville lodge opened, gold panning exhibitions held and hospitality dispensed in the famous old U. S. hotel.

While the entertainment in Jacksonville is holding forth, the nationally famous Ben Ali Chanters will present a program over radio station KMED. In the afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, Ben Ali's equally famous band will entertain southern Oregon people in the Medford city park.

Starting soon after 4 o'clock, a banquet will be held in the Medford Elks' club with plenty of entertainment until the forming of the big parade at 7 o'clock. Following this brilliant parade, in which Ben Ali's uniformed units and Hillah's band patrol and drum corps, will participate, all Shriners will assemble at the Medford armory for the joint ceremonial.

The entire program will be presented by Ben Ali's potentate, W. P. Neville, his divan, director and wrecking crew and southern Oregon members are eagerly anticipating the entire program. Elaborate preparations have been made and extensive properties have been assembled by Ben Ali temple for this brilliant affair.

Marching bodies will participate in the presentation of distinguished guests from scores of temples and concerts will be presented by various musical units.

Topping off the busy day, all the Shriners who participate in the glorious ceremonial will gather at the Medford Elks' club for a final good-fellowship session before the visitors entrain for Sacramento.

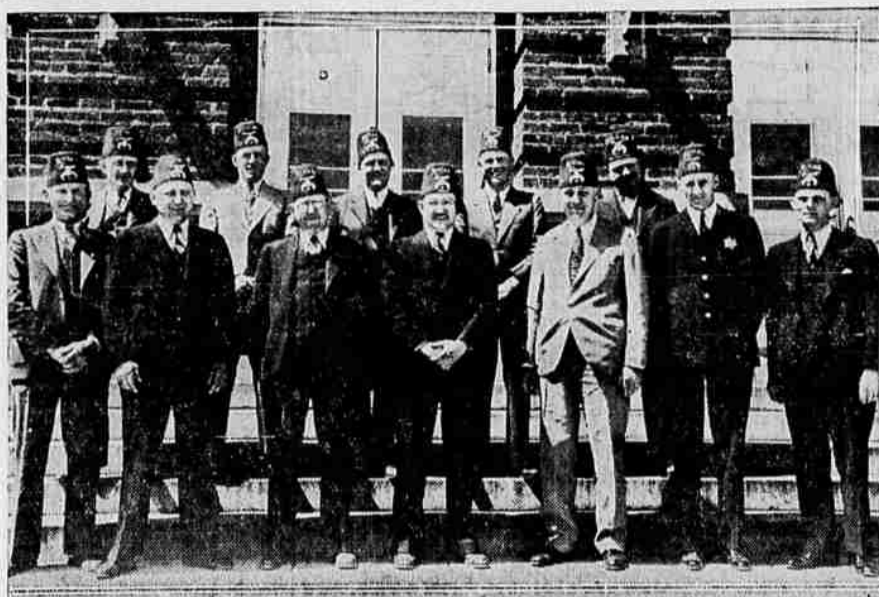
