

BRAIN TRUST HAS JOHNSONS BACKING

NASHVILLE, Tenn., June 22.—(AP)—President Roosevelt's "brain trust"—a "one-man brain trust"—carried the vigorous endorsement today of Gen. Hugh S. Johnson.

"Yes, there is a brain trust in Washington, all right," the NRA administrator said last night in an address, "but the brain is the brain of Franklin D. Roosevelt and the trust is the faith of the whole American people."

"What administration critics do not like," Johnson said, "is the fact that the brain trust is not a 'yes trust' their way."

All presidents have advisers, he said, but President Roosevelt's represent "the best brains of a cross-section of the United States," while some former presidents took counsel of "men from Wall street, men who looked as if they had just swallowed a watermelon."

GERMANY WARNS HER CREDITORS

BERLIN, June 22.—(AP)—A warning that she would sever commercial relations was Germany's answer today to threats of other nations to enforce collection of interest of her foreign debts.

Dr. Hjalmar Coehntz, president of the reichsbank, said bluntly "it is no use to threaten or scold us."

Following the reich's recent six-month moratorium on its obligations, France and England have discussed creating clearing houses which would impound German commercial funds to meet payments frozen by the moratorium.

ARMOUR CO. OFFICIAL SUICIDES IN BATHROOM

CHICAGO, June 22.—(AP)—Fred James Reynolds, 38, vice-president of Armour and Company in charge of purchasing, was found fatally wounded in the bathroom of his Glenwood home today.

He died at Highland park hospital a few minutes later.

His wife, Margaret, found him prostrate and summoned the police and a physician, but he died without regaining consciousness. Police said he apparently had taken his own life.

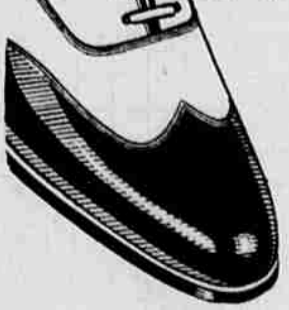

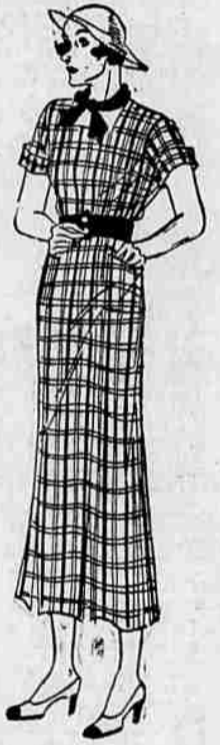
