for 35 years here, well known and respected. From the time he entered office he was the center of a series of tumultuous legal events, entirely out of keeping with the previous even tenor of his life.

The state, it is expected will contend that Schermerhorn, laying aside sentiment, is not legally entitled to parole; that his official position made him more culpable than others; that the principle involved in the parole is state wide, and not confined exclusively to Jackson county and that up-state feeling is opposed to leniency.

Sentiment Neutral  
Sentiment in this county and city is not strong either way. The majority feeling is one of neutrality. Friends of Schermerhorn hold a parole would temper mercy with justice. Others hold that leniency would be discrimination against others involved and serving sentences for conviction of the same crime.

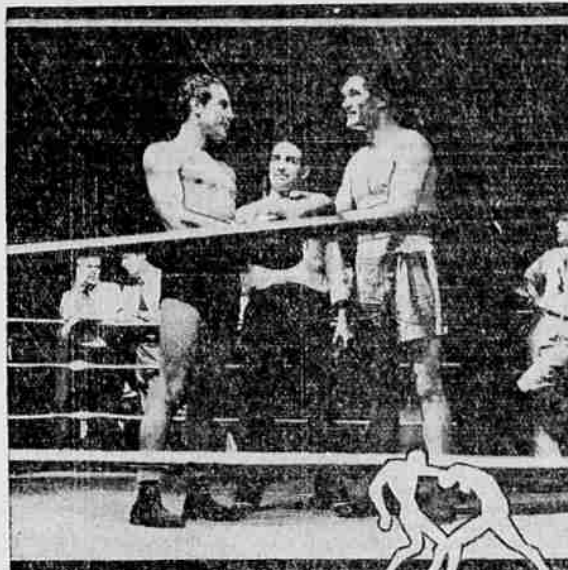
The hearing has attracted wide attention throughout the state, and former associates of Schermerhorn in the penitentiary for vote-stealing conviction are watching with keen interest the outcome. Friends of these men, in the event the parole is granted are scheduled to file applications for the same consideration. Schermerhorn's freedom while they were in durance has been no balm to them.

Schermerhorn was sentenced August 7 last, and has since been at liberty on \$7500 bonds.
