FIRST NEWSPAPER IN STATE PRINTED AT OREGON CITY Oregonian And Salem Statesman Among Early Establishments—First World News Months Old.

SALEM, Ore. (UP)—While editors and publishers of Oregon's numerous daily and weekly newspapers gathered in state convention at Roseburg, capitol historians recalled the early days of journalism and printing in the Northwest. The first printing on the Pacific coast, records showed, was done in 1839 at Lapwai, a small mission settlement in Oregon territory near the present city of Lewiston, Idaho. The press used was a small one sent from Honolulu by the American mission board, affiliated with the Congregational and Presbyterian churches. Religious literature was printed. Now in Museum. The press was used later for printing various periodicals in Oregon. It is on exhibition now at the Oregon Historical society museum at the Auditorium, Portland. The first Pacific coast newspaper was the Oregon Spectator, founded at Oregon City in February, 1846, by the Oregon Printing association. Col. W. H. T. Vail was president of the company and first editor. George L. Curry, later governor of Oregon territory, edited the paper for a time in 1853. The Spectator was printed on a Washington Hand press, shipped around Cape Horn to the Pacific coast. The press later was used to print the Oregon State Journal at Eugene. It is located now at the University of Oregon printing shop, where it is used occasionally. Oregonian A Pioneer. The Oregon Spectator suspended publication in March, 1855. By that time several other papers had been started in the territory. Chief among them was the Portland Oregonian and the Oregon Statesman, which have continued publication to the present day. The first issue of the Oregonian was printed December 4, 1850. The Oregon Statesman started publication at Oregon City, March 28, 1851. It moved to Salem in June, 1853, when the territorial capital was established here. Arthel Bush, first editor of the Statesman, also was the first state printer. Oregon newspapers now receive news by cable, telegram, teletype and telephone from all parts of the world the day it happens. Things were less simple in the forties and fifties of the last century, when it came to time. News Via Vessels. Early Oregon papers received much of their world-wide news, several weeks or months late, by clipping it from The Polynesian, a newspaper published in Honolulu, Hawaii. The Polynesian received news from the eastern part of the United States through trading vessels which piled regularly between New England and Oriental ports. Copies of the paper were carried to Oregon by supply schooners of the British Hudson Bay company, which operated trading posts at many points in the territory. Ships directly from the Atlantic to the Pacific coast were less frequent. A communication printed in one issue of the Honolulu paper read: "By the accompanying Polynesian you will perceive that I have advertised as you requested the 'Act.' You did not mention the nos. of times it was to be inserted. I have however concluded to let it remain in one month but shall charge you for but one insertion as per enclosed bill, which is receipted. If it be more convenient for you to make a remittance to me of \$8 in flour or salmon it will be equally acceptable, taking them at their cash values in Oregon. James J. Jarvis, editor of the Polynesian, to F. Prigg, secretary of Oregon Territory."
