

### \$468,972 SPENT IN ROGUE FOREST FOR FISCAL YEAR

### 39 Activities Take Major Portion of Funds, Report by Supervisor Janouch Shows—Many Get Work

Karl Janouch, supervisor of the Rogue River national forest, announced yesterday that in a report sent to the regional office at Portland, it was made public that the Rogue River national forest has made total expenditures amounting to \$468,972 during the fiscal year July 1, 1933, to July 1, 1934. Of this sum, \$65,000 was expended by the regional office.

That spent locally has been distributed among 39 activities, including maintenance of roads, trails, telephone lines and buildings, approximately \$50,000; construction of roads, trails, telephone lines and buildings, approximately \$350,000; projects carried on under emergency conservation work by CCC, approximately \$200,000, of which a part is not forest service funds; bureau of plant industry and blister rust control project, approximately \$50,000, and minor activities, including timber sale control, grazing, research, timber sales and administration of federal forest land uses.

**Many Given Work.**  
Through the approximate 70 per cent of these expenditures which have been made locally, Janouch stated, 600 men in Jackson county have been furnished employment during the past year.

Construction of the \$20,000 forest service warehouse on the McAndrews road, one-half mile east of the Pacific highway, started Thursday, with a crew secured through the federal employment agency. No applicants are received at the forest service offices, Janouch said, and all carpenters are taken from civil service rolls. Work will be provided for 12 or 13 men on this project for two months, with a crew engaged at present in laying 3200 feet of pipe to the main water-line.

The warehouse project will include an 80x100 foot warehouse, a 7x39 foot storage building, and a gasoline and oil station.

**Sig Ash Foreman.**  
Sig Ash, local contractor, is general foreman, with the water-pipe work under the supervision of Charles W. Davis, Owen-Oregon Lumber Co., a supplying lumber, Beaver Portland Cement Co. at Gold Hill, cement, and Medford Concrete Construction Co., gravel. The Lawrence Roofing Co. holds the roofing contract.

Another project starting yesterday, the road from Dead Indian soda springs to the Ashland-Dead Indian road, together with the road from the soda springs to Fish lake, which is now underway, provides employment for 80 local men, also hired through the federal employment service. This project, costing \$24,000, will enable motorists from Medford to make the trip to Fish lake either by way of Dead Indian soda springs or Ashland.

### NAVAL RECRUITS FROM THIS AREA PASS TEST HIGH

All the young men selected by Chief A. P. Walker, in charge of navy recruiting in this district, passed the first examinations at Portland, and are now enroute to the Navy Training school at San Diego, Cal.

This month's quota is composed of eight men, including Robt. L. Thurman, Medford; D. H. Nichols, Talent; C. L. Lusk, Jacksonville; C. A. Runnels, Eagle Point; F. Graves, Lakeview; H. P. Oliver, Trail; F. D. Reynolds, Klamath Falls, and A. M. Smith, Rogue River. This group made an average mark of 88 per cent in their mental, moral and physical examinations, which is exceptionally high. The general average is 75 per cent.

The quota for next month has not as yet been assigned, but Chief Walker expects that it will be increased to 10 men. He states that due to the many new ships being built and put in commission, opportunities for trade training and promotions in rating have been increased over what they have been in the past three years, and due to the re-assignments of fleet units, travel opportunities are unlimited.

Applications are now being accepted for selection in the September and October quotas. The recruiting office, located in the postoffice building, will be closed all day today and Saturday, as the chief is making a business trip through the Applegate country. The office will be open daily next week, from 9 a. m. to 3 p. m.
