

### COLBY HELD FOR GRAND JURY QUIZ MORALS CHARGE

J. Noel Colby, 29, of Grants Pass, charged with a morals offense involving a 14-year-old Jacksonville girl, was bound over to await action of the grand jury following a preliminary hearing held before Justice of the Peace William R. Coleman yesterday afternoon. Bonds were fixed at \$1500.

Colby, a married man, was represented by Attorney Chas. W. Beames and introduced no testimony in his own behalf.

During the hearing spectators were excluded from the court room. Some of the witnesses were young children.

Testimony of the prosecution, including that of the complaining witness, tended to show that Colby had induced her and two younger girls to take an auto ride and parked the car near the Jacksonville cemetery. He is alleged to have given the smaller girls a sum of money with instructions to buy candy. During their absence the attack is alleged to have taken place. The time was testified as a night last June.

Following the alleged assault Colby left Jacksonville. He returned a week ago and was allegedly recognized by the girl, who notified her father, and he in turn notified the authorities.

### EXPECT BUSINESS WILL GAIN SPEED AFTER LABOR DAY

NEW YORK, Aug. 31.—(AP)—Productive and distributive branches of trade, said the weekly Dun & Bradstreet trade review today, are looking forward to Labor day the turning point from a curtailment of production toward a period of recovery and expansion.

"After its maintenance at an unexpectedly high level since June," asserted the survey, "the consumer buying impetus gained rapidly in the closing week in August.

"As consumer buying turned pronouncedly stronger as the month drew to a close, many retailers had the best week of the summer, and sales rose as much as 15 per cent above the level of the week preceding and were 8 to 12 per cent larger than in the comparative period of 1933.

"In contrast to the encouraging progress being made in the distribution of merchandise, the rate of industrial activity continues to lag, and in many instances is becoming more dependent on federal or state expenditures.

"Even though the number of orders placed in some of the apparel divisions was somewhat under that of the week preceding, the volume of wholesale business was larger than a year ago and in most of the large markets buyers were more numerous than during that period."

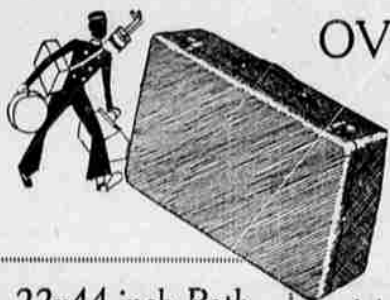
