

801,000 ACRES OF WILDERNESS WILL REMAIN UNDEFILED

One of Greatest Primitive Areas in Country Set Aside in Northern Washington by Forest Service

PORTLAND, Ore., Sept. 7.—(AP)—One of the greatest wilderness areas of the United States, where one can travel for 150 miles in one direction without crossing a road, has been officially set aside in northern Washington as the "North Cascade primitive area."

C. J. Buck, regional forester here, made the announcement today. The area comprises 801,000 acres, a territory considerably larger than Massachusetts, and as large as Glacier National park. It lies in the Mount Baker and Chelan national forests.

"In designating this primitive area," Buck said, "the forest service is meeting the increasing demand of our population for the preservation of certain primeval wilderness areas to be handed down in an undisturbed state to future generations. Contrary to our usual policy of opening recreation areas, there will be no roads, no hotels or cabin colonies in this primitive area."

The area is described as "a territory of stupendous peaks, canyons carved to awesome depths, waterfalls interspersed with exquisite mountain lakes under mighty glaciers and towering rock slides, set in pleasant contrast with large sections of friendly mountain meadows where a party with horses can travel and camp comfortably under conditions indescribably picturesque and romantic."

BLACK AND WHITE FUSION PREDICTED

ABERDEEN, Scotland, Sept. 7.—(AP)—The belief that the black and white races in America will merge into one was expressed today by Lord Raglan, chairman of the Anthropological society, before the British Association for the Advancement of Science in convention here.

"I believe," he told the scientists, "that before many centuries have elapsed there will not be a single person in America without a certain portion of negro blood."

WATCHMAN PEAK DRAWS VISITORS

CRATER LAKE NATIONAL PARK, Ore.—(Sp.)—Far ahead of last year's entire total, over 2000 people have visited the Watchman observation station so far this season, indicative of the growing popularity of this park feature, located on the first high point on the west rim.

The station not only provides a rare panoramic view of Crater Lake and countless miles of forest country, but serves as a fire protection measure as well. A attendant in charge is well trained in the art of fire detection and is constantly watching the wooded areas for tell-tale smoke signs. A lookout station on Mt. Scott, on the opposite side of the lake, provides the park with a complete fire protection system, in conjunction with numerous miles of motorways.

The Watchman station can be reached as a result of a short walk from the rim road, following a five-mile drive from the lodge.

PAIR ARRESTED AS 'AMBULANCE CHASERS'

OREGON CITY, Sept. 7.—(AP)—Accused of being "ambulance chasers" four unidentified Portland attorneys, Norman E. Redmond and Irving Harila were indicted by the Clatsop county grand jury yesterday on charges of "soliciting business, litigation and lawsuit on account of claim for personal injury."

The two were taken in custody last week in a Portland office. They pleaded not guilty and were held under \$1,500 bond each.

PICKERS WALK OUT IN POLK HOP YARDS

DALLAS, Ore., Sept. 7.—(AP)—Sheriff T. B. Hooker of Polk county said today he had been advised that more than 2,500 pickers in three Polk county hopyards have walked out on strike.

The yards involved, he was told, were the Horst ranch near Independence where 2,000 pickers were employed; the R. E. Williams yard near Hota, and the Alluvial farms yard near Independence.

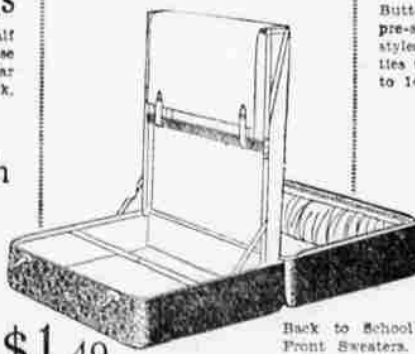
