

KIRKLAND FARM STOCK SENT TO PORTLAND SHOW

A carload of fat, sleek cattle was shipped last week by the Kirkland farm, owned by Mrs. Ruth Sparrow, to Portland for exhibit at the Pacific International Livestock Exposition. The car was loaded Tuesday at the Seven Oaks side track by employees of the farm.

Included in the car was the big thoroughbred bull, which has headed the herd for some time. With him were three milk cows and several calves, besides a younger bull. The cattle are all of the Milking Shorthorn breed and had been specially groomed for the big show.

Tom Harrison, foreman at the Kirkland farm, who accompanied the car to Portland, said before leaving he hoped to bring home some good prizes with his cattle. Part of the young stock will be sold at the show; also the big bull. The milk cows, however, are not for sale.

Doyle Mills, who has been employed at the Kirkland farm for several years, also went along to assist in the care of the cattle enroute. They expect to be gone about two weeks.—Central Point American.

HIGHER WAGES BY NRA VISUALIZED

PORTLAND, Oct. 8.—(AP)—A higher minimum wage under NRA was visualized today by J. Frank Grimes, president of the Independent Grocers' alliance, as a move that "will open an era of production and consumption far beyond our wildest dreams."

He predicted the \$15 minimum will disappear within a few years because recent studies indicated the average family cannot maintain American standards on less than \$35.

"The financial end industrial east admits a farmer is entitled to a fair price for his crops. Labor has discovered capital is entitled to a just return, and now the last side of the triangle will be completed when workers are granted a wage of decent proportion."

PORTLAND BUTTER MARKET STEADY

PORTLAND, Oct. 8.—(AP)—Market for butter was steady although the right-about face of the produce exchange in the advancing of extra 1/2 lb. was in effect. This placed first and second grade butter in their accustomed price class here.

The produce exchange advance in the price on special eggs now effective, followed action taken last week by Oregon laid eggs and poultry when it made a further boost in the price. Pullets are now showing strength locally.

Market continued practically steady for cheese. From all sections of the country the past week a fairly favorable tone was suggested.
