

### DUNNE'S RECORD SHOWS HIM UP, SAYS SAM BROWN

Marion Co. Leader Warns Voters Against G. O. P. Candidate As Exponent of Chicago Alley Politics

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 12.—(Sp.)—Without committing himself to support any candidate, Senator Sam Brown of Marion county, in a radio address delivered over KOIN last night, declared that "I am certain that the candidacy of Joe Dunne constitutes the greatest menace threatening the people of Oregon today."

Senator Brown, who was runner-up in the Republican gubernatorial primary last spring, asserted that he is not supporting the Republican nominee and cautioned the voters against injecting "Chicago alley politics into Oregon." Brown played Dunne as a "charlatan senator, addicted to carrying water on both shoulders, who was with the dairymen at milking time and with the milk distributors at delivery time; with the vets in the morning and the W. C. T. U. in the afternoon."

**Knows Dunne's Record**  
Brown stated that emissaries of Dunne came to him, and finally Dunne, to show what political appointments could be bestowed upon him in return for support. He declared his refusal to support Dunne is based upon the fact that "I know his record."

Senator Brown said that a good way to judge the kind of a record a candidate for office will make in the future is to "look up his record of the past." Men do not change their ideas or ideals much in going from one office to another.

**Expensive to Taxpayers**  
Pointing to Dunne's record, Brown, who served with Dunne during all the time he has been in the senate, said that he has introduced 183 bills, memorials and resolutions, not including bills introduced by committee of which he was a member. "The cost of printing these bills, of clerical hire and occupying the time of the legislature entails an enormous expense to the state," Brown said.

**For Vested Interests**  
The bills introduced by Dunne, Brown said, cover every subject ranging from a "five cent loaf of bread to the regulation of scavenger wagons," and from authorizing the state to issue scrip backed by a half million appropriation to exempting fraternities from taxation. Bills introduced by Dunne created more inspectors than those by any other legislator, Brown said.

"Rarely was Dunne's vote recorded on the side of economy," but he "allied himself with the forces of extravagance," Brown stated, and continued by adding that Dunne was always to be found with the vested interests and running with the pack.

**Against Economy**  
Mentioning certain bills, Brown said that Dunne voted against a reduction in salaries of state officials for a two-year period; sponsored salary increase measures, introduced a bill to take the \$250 a month maximum limit off the salary of the secretary to the public service commissioner, supported a bill to create two additional judgeships in Multnomah county and to override the governor's veto of the bill.

**First a Lobbyist**  
"As a lobbyist and ice cream manufacturer before he became a senator, Mr. Dunne" opposed a bill to increase the butterfat content of ice cream and later as a senator introduced a bill to license large ice cream manufacturers \$25 annually and the small "two or three quart freezer" oftentimes used by confectioners \$100 annually, Brown declared. He points out that Dunne favored the \$5 auto license fee which charges the man with a new high-priced car the same as the same car owner with an old car.

"Immediately upon the passage of the \$5 license bill an additional 1 cent tax was placed on gasoline. This additional thrust at the poor man was energetically championed by the genial Senator Dunne," Brown said.

**For and Also Against**  
Dunne, Brown declared, promised to vote against the sales tax bill which had been overwhelmingly defeated by the people, but instead he voted for the sales tax and voted against referring it to the people at the May, 1934, primary. The truck and bus law "so ably championed by Senator Dunne" is "his masterpiece," Brown stated. He termed the bill one of the "most vicious bills ever enacted into law."

Another one of Dunne's bills is the milk control bill, Brown stated, with a budget twice the size of the department of agriculture, the money raised from a tax on the dairyman's produce. He said that since the passage the price of milk has advanced materially with 65 per cent of the increase going to the distributors. Passage of the bill is termed by Brown "a crime against society."  
Brown pointed out that Dunne opposed the Orange power bill as he did other bills where "the same would conflict with the interests of the utilities." He pointed to Dunne's many promises for roads in all parts of the state, and for "frozen eggs for Eugene, grubstakes for miners at Baker—and so on and on and on."

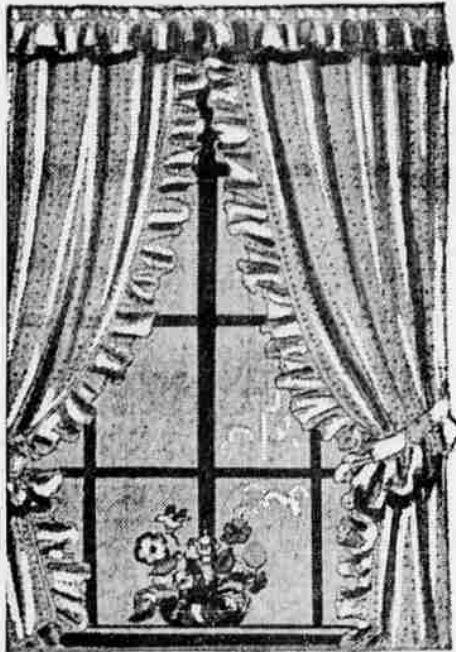

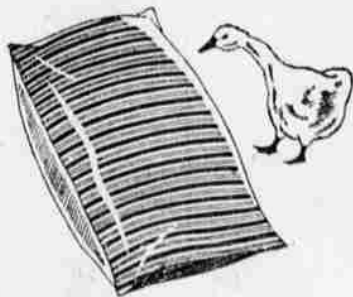
