

SINCLAIR FORCES WILL BATTLE FOR DEM PARTY HELM

'Epic' Backers Win 17 Seats in Assembly—Call to Battle for Party Control Is Issued by State Chairman

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 8.—(P)—A battle for control of the Democratic party in California loomed today as Upton Sinclair, defeated nominee for governor, rallied his "Epic" forces to consolidate a foothold gained in state offices.

Though Sinclair's own bid was buried in Tuesday's avalanche of votes—returns from 10,251 of 11,721 precincts showing him trailing Republican Governor Frank P. Merriam 1,071,318 to 833,212—other "Epic" Democrat candidates fared better.

Culbert Olson, Sinclair's chief campaign lieutenant, was elected to the state senate, and "Epic" backers captured at least 17 seats in the assembly and one of the four coveted places on the state board of education—important tax and liquor control body.

Battle Cry Sounded. The call to battle for control of the party was issued by Olson in his capacity as Democratic state central committee chairman—a post to which he was named after Sinclair won the party's nomination in the primary election.

"Only those who remained loyal to the Democratic party during the recent campaign will remain in the party and be recognized as Democrats," Olson declared following a Los Angeles meeting at which Sinclair acted as chairman.

The challenge was accepted by William E. Neblett, Los Angeles, law partner of United States Senator William G. McAdoo, and William Jennings Bryan, Jr., both of whom refused to support Sinclair for the governorship.

Neblett declared that the "Democrats will repudiate Epic," and Sinclair retorted "the Democrats will repudiate Neblett."

Bryan, whose famous father was once the national leader of the party, declared: "Upton Sinclair, who is not now and never was a Democrat, must no longer be regarded a leader in the Democratic party. His invasion has been repudiated."

McAdoo Aloud. As the hostilities were opened, Senator McAdoo remained aloof. He said he "voted the Democratic ticket all the way through," and expressed belief that Sinclair "would have been elected governor of California if he had consistently adhered to the Democratic platform adopted at Sacramento."

Senator McAdoo hailed the party's national victory, which included the election of 12—possibly 13—congressmen to California's 20 seats, as a verdict for the new deal. "The Republican party is dead," he said.

The doubtful California seat in the house of representatives was in the 12th district, where John N. Hoepfel, Democrat, was leading his Republican opponent, Frederick Houser, 43,645 to 42,028. In returns from 365 of 430 precincts. If Hoepfel wins it will be a gain of two in the state's representation for the party.
