**AERIAL SERVICE
TO LAKEVIEW AND
KLAMATH BEGINS**

The Oregon Air Service commences its regular mail and passenger service today.

Preliminary work for substituting the new service has been hurriedly completed in the Klamath region recently, and the Medford region is being covered at the present time.

Business men to the three southern Oregon cities have contributed their support individually and through heavy endorsement by the various chambers of commerce. In order to secure adequate financial support until federal requirements are met, the installation of Portland, which commences with main line mail planes, a reduction of from 20 to 30 hours in the delivery and receipt of eastern mail and communications will be accomplished by the service.

Applications for the establishment of a connecting air mail line from Klamath Falls to either Roseburg or Medford are under way. For this purpose Mr. Handall, manager, contemplates the purchase of a heavy duty 40-hp biplane which is especially built to accommodate heavy mail loadings.

OKLAHOMA CITY, Nov. 8.—(AP)—With Alvin Karpavich and Margaret Hurlentine in custody at Roseburg, Oregon, the list of those held in connection with the kidnapping of Charles F. Duce from his home here on July 1933, had been increased to 27. The arrest of Scott was reported by federal agents to have resulted in the recovery of \$1,850 of the \$200,000 ransom paid, but \$100,000 remains unrecovered.
