

### RICKENBACKER IN NEW AIR RECORD ACROSS COUNTRY

NEWARK, N. J., Nov. 8.—(AP)—Captain Eddie Rickenbacker's prophetic of a new transcontinental speed record for transport planes has come true.

After breakfasting in Los Angeles, the war ace with two co-pilots and three passengers flew into the Newark airport last night in his big twin motored (Douglas) Airliner.

Florida Flyer, "all set for dinner in New York." His time was 12 hours, 3 minutes and 50 seconds.

They took off from the Union Airport, Los Angeles, at 8:25 a. m., eastern standard time yesterday, and landed at 8:45:50 p. m., cutting 30 minutes and 50 seconds from Rickenbacker's old record.

Flying over the transcontinental Western Airlines course, with a 12 minutes stop at Kansas City for refueling, the ship averaged 221 miles an hour.

"At one point over the Rockies we hit 17,000 feet," said Rickenbacker. "Then we had to use the oxygen tanks for a few minutes. Our top speed was 237 miles an hour."

It was a "gesture," that former record flight February 19, when Rickenbacker set his transport plane down in Newark from Los Angeles in 18 hours and 2 minutes, just before the army took over the air mail.

Yesterday's flight was made to show how speedily, yet safely, the trip may be made.

The record for speed planes is 10 hours, 2 minutes, held by Colonel Roscoe Turner.

"Red" Franklin has regained the stride which carried him to national gridiron fame when he was returning kickoff for touchdowns last year. He will capt. the Beavers Saturday.

Coch. Frank Callison drilled the webfoots intensively on defense this week, in preparation for the strong offense the Beavers are expected to show with Franklin back in the fray.

Football interest is blazing high at Eugene, so high in fact that the student body president decided his gavel welding henceforth will be done between football practice sessions.

He is Joe Renner, a former dashing halfback of Jefferson high, who donned the mole skin only a week ago, but has been named in the squad of 31 Webfoots to be in suit here tomorrow.

Also co-captain Bob Parke of Oregon stiff-armed the talk that his injured arch would keep him on the sidelines. In suit with Parke and ready to play was Bud Jones, his injured knee increased in a brace made by Colonel Bill Hayward, inventive trainer.

Oregon's strong offense depends largely on shaking "Flea" Van Vliet loose for long gains and on the passes he throws. Fullback Michak is a more versatile ball carrier than was Mike Mikulak, but does not possess quite the brute drive of Iron Mike.

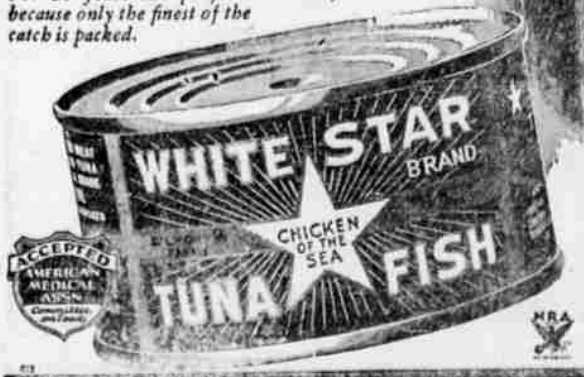
